The proposed 2026 summer arts academy is a six week session, Monday-Friday from 8:00am until 3:00 pm June 8, 2026 to July 17, 2026.

The purpose of the Summer Arts Academy is to holistically develop and nurture the gifts of the arts and build collaborative skills within a Christian Environment. This year we will offer two art magnets: **dance and artist**. The dance magnet will include: ballet, modern/creative movement, hip-hop, and liturgical. The artist magnet will consist of: art classes, choir, piano, summer reading, and Spanish. All of our academy instructors are professionally trained and hold various degrees in their field of expertise.

Pertinent information

Dance 5-18yrs: \$75 registration fee and \$130 per week (ballet, modern, contemporary, hip-hop and liturgical and creative movement for younger students) Dancers will be placed according to ability not age.

Artist Magnet: \$75 registration fee and \$130 per week (art, choir, piano, and summer reading/writing, Spanish)

Payments can be made by visiting our website www.ngaainc.com, We accept ACE, PFCC/Title XX public funding, private pay. Payments are collected two weeks prior so that we can cover all costs by the end of camp. Additionally, payment is based on spots reserved not attendance. If you pay in advance and the student does not attend there will be no refunds unless there is an extreme medical reason. To add, if a student attends one day but not the remainder of the week payment will not be pro-rated.

There is a payment plan located on the website to help pay for camp over time vs. weekly. Families must register by February in order to enroll in the early pay off plan.

Placements: **All dancers will have to participate in placement on May 16, 2026 10am,** 2800 E. River Road Moraine, OH 45439. Attire: black leotards, nude tights. Students will be assessed for technique and basic rhythm and movement. Please note all dancers **may not** be selected for the dance program. In the event your student is not admitted into the dance program, they will automatically be enrolled in arts magnets.

PFCC/Title 20: Notably Gifted must be listed as your child's service provider before they can attend camp. Our program license number is 2220027252

Attendance: Our program is **not** a drop-in program. Attendance is required in order to acquire skills. Students are only permitted to miss 4 days for the entire camp. Students who miss more than 4 days of camp will not be able to perform in the finale showcase. If your student will be absent please report it in advance to the magnet coordinators.

Timeliness: Breakfast begins at 7:30am. We will not accept students prior to that time. Camp begins at 8:00am. We will stop receiving students at 8:15am. If you arrive later than 8:15 am

without advanced approval your student will not be permitted to camp for the day.

After camp care: 3-5:00pm. Cost is an additional \$50 per week per child and must be paid in advance. If students attend one day the payment will not be pro-rated.

Late fees: Fees will be assessed at 3:05pm or 5:05pm for after care.

- 1st late pick up fee is \$15 **per child**
- 2nd late fee is \$20 **per child**
- 3rd will discuss possible removal from camp

Fundraisers: We will have camp fundraisers. To be explained and picked up during camp meeting.

Families who do not engage in the fundraisers will be required to either make a donation of \$100 or pay for their students' costumes/music books and shirts which you will keep.

Finale Showcase: Friday July 17, 2026 location TBD

Wednesday 7/16/26 extended rehearsal until 5:00pm

Thursday 7/15/26 extended day dress rehearsal until 4:30pm

Friday 7/17/26 students report to the building at 10:30am we will transport students to location for the Finale.

Youth Works: High School students 14+ are encouraged to apply for Youth Works at the Department of Job and Family Services and select Notably Gifted as a work site. Students will be able to attend camp and gain work experience.

Duties for Youth workers:

- Assist with pick up and drop off
- Prepare space for breakfast and clean up
- Prepare classrooms
- Janitorial work (cleaning bathrooms, eating areas, sweeping hallways, emptying trash etc)
- Assisting teachers as needed/teacher aides
- Assisting with lunch duty and clean up

- Assisting with nap time and restroom breaks for younger students

College Scholarship opportunities:

Each summer our high school students complete the camp, they will earn \$150 scholarship funding. Students participating the freshman year through senior year will receive \$600. Students must participate junior year and complete two summers for a total of \$300. Funding is earned every summer and students must complete the summer of their senior year. Checks will be made payable to college/university on behalf of the student.

Ballet shoes split sole canvas ballet shoes (**NO leather and NO BLACK except for boys**)

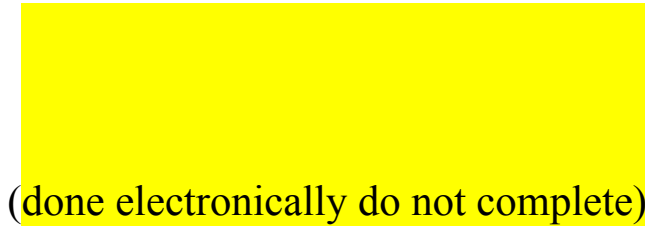
Hair pulled into a bun (absolutely no beads for dancers) Water bottle)
