**NOTICE OF RACE
ICEBREAKER RACE
March 27, 2021**



1. Rules

- 1.1. The series will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2014, except as modified by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2. RRS Rules 26 and A3 are changed to allow for a starting window.
- 1.3. RRS Rule 33 is changed to allow for movement of marks during a race.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. Participation is open to all keelboats, subject to PHRF handicapping.
- 2.2. Boats may enter as PHRF Cruising or Leisure Fleets (In-mast furling main and/or a beam/draft ratio of $\leq 39\%$). A minimum of two boats are required to form a fleet.
- 2.3. Boats may be sailed singlehanded.
- 2.4. All boats shall be equipped with a VHF radio.
- 2.5. PHRF handicaps will be established by the TSC Chief Handicapper.
- 2.6. Boats are encouraged to register online. Participants may also register onsite at the TSC Clubhouse. Execution of a Liability Release Agreement shall be required. Registration will open approximately two weeks before the first race.
- 2.7. All boats are required to check in at the TSC clubhouse no later than 1030 prior to the day's racing, even if the boat is pre-registered by mail or other means.

3. Fees

- 3.1. Fees for TSC Members will be \$25 per boat for each individual day's racing.
- 3.2. Fees for Non-Members will be \$30 per boat for each individual day's racing.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. This race is scheduled for March 27, 2021. One (1) race is scheduled. Postponed or abandoned races may be sailed on a later date on the club's calendar.
- 4.2. Daily Schedule

1000-1030	Registration at TSC Clubhouse and individual Skipper's Orientation with the Race Committee
1155	First Warning Signal
1200	First Start of the day

No Warning signal after 1530

Socially Distanced Awards available on Clubhouse Deck approximately 30 minutes after the close of any protest period and after scoring has been finalized.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration and at each day's Skipper's Meeting. If published in time, they may also be posted on the TSC website.

5. Venue:

- 5.1. Races will be conducted on the waters of Lake Texoma, with starting areas announced in each race day's Skipper's Meeting.
- 5.2. Grandpappy Point Marina is the location of the series harbor.

6. Courses: Fixed Mark courses are planned. Fleets and distances to be sailed will be determined prior to the Skipper's Orientation.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. The Low Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will apply.
- 7.2. Handicaps established by TSC will be used to determine a boat's corrected time based upon Time On Distance calculation to determine a boat's finishing place.
- 7.3. For TSC members only, this day's race results will be utilized for TSC Championship points.

8. Berthing: Boats requesting an overnight berth should contact Grand Pappy Marina for availability.

9. Awards

- 9.1. Boats in First, Second and Third Place in the final standing of a Fleet shall receive an award. If 4 or less boats are entered in a Fleet, only two awards will be given. If 2 boats are entered in a Fleet, only one award will be given.
- 9.2. Scoring and awards will be available approximately 30 minutes after the close of any protest period and when scoring is completed. Awards may be picked up at the TSC Clubhouse on a come and go basis by individual competitors.
