The **mission** of Darby Christian Academy is to equip homeschool families and students to discern truth, pursue goodness, and delight in beauty for God's glory through a robust Christian education. We exist to resource—not replace—parents as the primary educators of their children. As we engage this mission, we seek to cultivate the worship of God, wonder at His creation, and wisdom to live rightly ordered lives towards the Creator and within His creation.

We seek to promote discipleship and maturity in children as whole souls by addressing all facets of their being: mental, physical, spiritual, and emotional.

Our intentions lay not only in the enrichment of individuals, but to be a resource and support to like-minded families, churches, and ministries.

We facilitate our **mission** through a unique community (hybrid) school model, which consists of two campus days of classroom instruction and three homeschool days a week, using lesson plans crafted by our teachers and administered by parents. This is a dedicated partnership between the school and the family.

We set about our mission using a **methodology** that combines Christian Classical education and the Charlotte Mason method. This involves reading great books, spending time in nature, an emphasis on the trivium (grammar, logic, rhetoric; what things *are*, what things *mean*, and how to *communicate* them) and the history and culture of Western Civilization, and developing a Christian worldview.
