

Anticipated Costs for Troop 1681

December, 2023

Required, Paid online

1. \$25 New-Member Joining Fee (youth or adult) if no prior participation, in addition to Membership Fee. No pro-rating.
2. \$80 Youth Registration Fee. No pro-rating.
3. \$6 Liability Insurance Fee.
4. \$15 Scout Life Subscription. No pro-rating. We ask that a subscription be in place for the household to allow our Troop to be considered a 100% enrolled Troop.
5. \$60 Adult Registration Fee. No pro-rating. Plus \$6 Liability Insurance Fee.
6. \$25 MB Counselors. No pro-rating.

Required, Paid to Troop

7. \$25/year prorated dues to cover cost of awards and supplies, payable to the Troop.
8. \$16 Scout Handbook, spiral bound. These outlast those with regular binding. Available from Troop
9. \$10 for campout food for 3 meals.

Optional, recommended, but..... Paid to Troop

10. \$12-\$15: Official Shirt – from Troop Uniform Bank.
11. ? Patches for Shirt: Council Patch (\$6), Patrol Patch (\$3), numerals (\$6 set), World Crest & World Crest Ring (\$5 set), Shoulder Loops (\$5), Journey to Excellence Patch (no charge).
12. \$12-\$15: Official Pants or Shorts – we have several sizes in Troop Uniform Bank.
13. \$15 Troop Neckerchief - custom made, (woggle - color coded for patrols, - no charge).
14. \$30 Troop T-Shirts custom made: Gray & Blue - includes both.
15. \$11 Official Socks – new.
16. \$20 Official Belt – new.
17. \$25 Troop First Aid Kit (assembled at Troop meeting, required for lower rank, to be with the Scout on hikes and campouts).
18. \$15 Merit Badge Sash – small, medium, or large, new.
19. \$15 Lexan plastic plate, bowl, cup, & utensils
20. ? Personal Equipment – See separate handout.

Things to keep in mind regarding uniform costs: A sports season typically last 2-3 months. Boys do not play or practice unless the registration fee and uniform fee is paid. However, a Scouting season is a year long, but the registration fee and uniform costs are about the same as the sports fees.
