Partnerships with Habitat for Humanity and Menifee Better Together to paint homes and beautify lawns in our community, and a monthly sock distribution for persons in need, in collaboration with Murrieta United Methodist Church. Our Delta DEARS host a bookmobile for the Julia Lee Performing Arts School in Lake Elsinore. MTAAC has provided community workshops on estate planning and financial literacy; involved the community in Physical and Mental Health initiatives; collaborated with the National Council of Negro Women and the Inland Empire Men's Club to provide hygiene products and haircuts for citizens of our community. Last, but not least, our organization hosts three youth programs for adolescents and young people in our community.

Our service to the community has earned MTAAC Regional recognition as the 2022 Farwest Small Chapter of the Year, Exemplary Program awards for our Delta Academy and EMBODI programs (2023); and National Recognition for our Delta Academy program (First Place, Small Chapter, 2023).
