

Policy

Full payment is required upon registration to secure your seat. We do require a minimum of 4 students to run the class. Class fees do not include HST, fabric and supplies are required unless otherwise noted. Upon your registration you will receive a supply list require for the class. You require to bring your own sewing machine and/or serger (in good working order) with a basic sewing kit such as machine needles, thread, seam ripper, scissors, straight pins, pencil/pen and note pad. Additional supplies required, including fabrics, will be stated on your supply list. Please arrive 5 to 10 minutes early to get organized. We are a <u>Scent Free</u> facility due to severe allergens. We ask that you please refrain from wearing perfumes and cosmetic scents, as well as using spray adhesives and other strongly scented items in the class. Should a class be cancelled due to lack of registrations, you will be notified one week prior to scheduled class time and will receive a full refund. However, if you the student has to cancel a registered class you are required to cancel one week prior to scheduled class to receive a full refund. Masks are to be worn during class time. Students are also required to be fully vaccinated.
