

## PRESIDENT'S INBOX: JOE HENRY '75



Dear ALHS Alumni,

I am filled with gratitude for the opportunity to serve as the ALHS Alumni Foundation president and celebrate the incredible legacy of Abraham Lincoln High School.

Abraham Lincoln High School has the largest population of students in the Des Moines school district and ranks in the top four in statewide population, serving nearly 2,400 students. It is a place where dreams are nurtured, and futures are shaped.

Our alumni foundation scholarships have opened doors and created opportunities for students who may not have had the means to further their education. In 1990 we began with two modest \$500 scholarships, but as our foundation grew, so did our commitment to supporting our students, increasing the amount and length of scholarships.

In 2003, we took a significant step forward by partnering with the national nonprofit Scholarship America, allowing us to expand our reach and effectiveness as a local "Dollars for Scholars" chapter. In recent years, we have awarded over \$100,000 annually, leading to a remarkable total of \$1.5 million in scholarships to date, with our current accounts reflecting a robust balance of \$3,072,440.

This spring alone, we proudly awarded 85 scholarships, totaling \$123,200, at our Annual Celebration Dinner at the Holiday Inn - Airport. With 468 seniors in the 2024 graduating class, we have successfully reached almost 20% of those students. This achievement underscores our foundation's commitment to ensuring that financial barriers do not hinder our students' academic aspirations.

Moreover, at our Annual Celebration we inducted three distinguished alumni into our Alumni Hall of Fame: **Dr. Andrew Pruitt '68**, **Craig Matzke '77**, and **Alan Kincheloe '80**. Their dedication, achievements, and hard work are a testament to the values instilled at ALHS, and we are proud to honor their contributions to our community.

Looking ahead, we are excited about the future as we anticipate an influx of scholarship applications from seniors.

## FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Greetings,

This school year is off to a good start. We are serving over 2350 students from a variety of cultures and backgrounds.

Our largest group of students are Latino students (38%), followed by white (30%), black (17%) and Asian (8%). This year we have 510 students identified as ELL students who represent 51 different countries and speak 41 different languages.

Our new all-purpose practice facility is ahead of schedule. The new facility is being built below Hutchens stadium and will serve football, soccer, track, marching band, as our every-day PE classes. This new facility will have artificial grass with an 8-lane track and lights. As soon as this project is completed, our district will begin building a new eight court tennis facility at Brody Middle School for our boys and girls tennis programs. Last year we made a big push with our students and staff to be intentional about developing a community where everyone felt like they belong. Each year students and staff are asked to complete the Panorama Survey which measures exactly this. At the end of last year, the survey revealed significant growth as a result of the efforts we put in during the year. Students increased their overall self-efficacy by 11 points. Within this category: \*When complicated ideas are

presented in class, how confident are you that you can understand them? and \*How confident are you that you can learn all the material presented to you in classes? Both increased by double digits. For the staff: \*How supportive are students in their interactions with each other? and \*How respectful are the relationships between teachers and students? Both saw double digit increases.

As a school, we will continue to build genuine relationships with our students while helping them build confidence. These two items can't be done separately, and thanks for a dedicated staff, we are able to make a difference. We invite you to come and see our progress anytime at Abraham Lincoln High School. You are always welcome to drop by.

## **WILL REMAIN IN OUR HEARTS**


As in any year, we lose some of our dear Alumni friends. This year is no different as you'll see on page 13. They all remain in our hearts.




