





Avery found SCO when she needed us most!

Four-year-old Avery arrived at Shriners Children's Ohio in June 2021, just two months after a fiery car crash near her home in Tennessee left her with burns covering more than 60% of her body. Avery spent several weeks at another hospital until a doctor who was familiar with Shriners suggested she go to our facility for care.

When she arrived, Avery could not sit up or walk on her own. Thanks to Avery's determination combined with SCO's skilled medical team, she was sitting a month after her arrival. Her dad says he even started seeing some of her personality come back. Avery loves to laugh, play in the PT room and give hugs.

Avery is getting comfortable wearing her pressure garments and facemask and learning with her dad about the stretches in between clinic appointments. Avery's dad repeatedly thanks Shriners Children's Ohio for the "amazing" care to Avery.

Aubrey receives first Hero Arm at Lexington Medical Center!

Aubrey said she tends to stand out amongst the other students in the hallways of her elementary school. The 9-year-old has a bilateral below-elbow congenital deficiency, meaning she was born missing her forearms.

"I have elbows and very small hands below that but no wrists," Aubrey said. "When I walk through the hallways at school, kids can always notice that I don't have arms."

After her most recent visit to Shriners Hospitals for Children Medical Center — Lexington, though, Aubrey anticipates her schoolmates will take notice of her for a different reason.

Aubrey is the first recipient of a Hero Arm at the Lexington medical center. The Hero Arm, built by Open Bionics, is a custom lightweight myoelectric prosthesis. The artificial limb is controlled with the electrical signals generated naturally by Aubrey's own muscles. Sensors in the arm detect muscle movements, making the arm intuitive for the wearer.

"I think my friends at school are going to think that it's really cool, and they'll be even more afraid of me," Aubrey said with a chuckle and

elaborated that she's a black belt in karate and her friends are already impressed by that.

Aubrey has been a patient of Janet Walker, M.D., at the Lexington medical center since she was 2 months old. She receives prosthetics care from the Pediatrics Orthotics and Prosthetics Services — Midwest housed at the medical center.

Over the years she has tried other prosthetics, including a harness-style device and a rubber "scoop," but nothing seemed to be just right for her needs.

Recently, though, the option for a Hero Arm was presented to Aubrey and her parents, and they jumped at the opportunity.

"This is the start of the dream prosthetic for her," Jennifer, Aubrey's mom, said. "It's very exciting that this technology is available."

When asked how it felt when everything finally "clicked," and she was able to work the device, Aubrey simply responded with a "thumbs up" with her new arm.
