

BASIC GUIDELINES FOR PEER DISCUSSION GROUPS

Share the Air

Everyone who wishes to share has an opportunity to do so. No one person should monopolize the group time.

One person speaks at a time

Each person should be allowed to speak free from interruption and side conversations.

• What is said here stays here

This is the essential principle of confidentiality, and <u>MUST</u> be respected by all.

• Differences of opinion are OK

We are **ALL** entitled to our own point of view.

• We are all equal

Accept cultural, linguistic, social and racial differences.

• Use "I" language

Because we do not participate in discussions groups as credentialed professionals, **NO ONE CAN INSTRUCT.**

• It's OK not to share

People do not have to share if they do not wish to. Much can be gained by just listening.

• It is everyone's responsibility to make the discussion groups a safe place to share. Respect confidentiality, treat each other with respect and kindness, and show compassion.
