### Proposed change to the Chicago Area Chapter ByLaws.

At our March meeting the following motion to change to the Bylaws was made, seconded and passed. At the April meeting at Schaumburg it was amended to delete **a minimum of 8 each year** and rewritten as **a minimum of 6 each year** and passed. Having provided adequate notice, it will be voted upon by the Chapter members present at the meeting May 7th at DuPage.

Final language reads as follows:

Regular monthly business meetings - **a minimum of 6 each year**- will be held at any time and any place including via teleconference proposed by the Chapter Chair and announced in advance to the members in the monthly newsletter.

All other activities, aviation, educational as well as social shall be held without business being conducted.

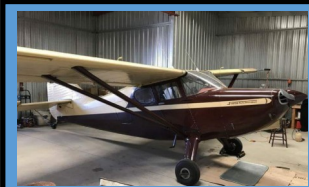
