Ground Rules

- Please be aware of the Order of Events – this is posted. Please be ready when you are called for your event. Please be aware of the Time Limits for each event – this is posted. **3 calls and you will be TURNED OUT.**
- Contestants are encouraged and asked to participate in the Grand Entry. Starts right at 7:50 AM.
- Midget Division – Goat Tagging – *for safety reasons* – Contestants in this event **MAY NOT** wear spurs. Violation of said rule will result in a disqualification.
- The designated alleyways for entering the arena and exiting the arena will be utilized for the Barrels & Poles.
- Barrel Racing: Circling horse before a run or causing unnecessary delay before beginning pattern; intentionally knocking off hat with hand; and not being ready when called will be cause for disqualification. As a general reminder and courtesy for this rodeo since we have a high number of contestants, we would like to recommend that you tie your hat down, pull them down harder than usual, etc., so they will not fall off so easily, we ask this because we would expedite the rodeo to the best of our ability. Thank you.
- Rakes will be every 7 runners.
- Rough Stock: Mandatory – protective vest and mouthpiece. Helmet is optional.
- **DRESS CODE WILL BE ENFORCED, THIS INCLUDES HELPERS.**
- The committee will draw stock for the following events – WR, SR, SB, BB, BR, TD and SW. Rest of Stock is chute run.
- Breakaway strings can be picked up from the Arena Director, a reminder, to remove all old strings from your rope when tying on the new one. No Tails are allowed in the breakaway roping.
- Goat tying, if the contestant's horse crosses over the goat or rope, or if the contestant's horse comes in contact with the goat or rope at any time, a five second penalty will be assessed.
- If you need clarification, please contact the judges or the Arena Director. The Rodeo Committee will not tolerate unsportsmanlike conduct or inhumane treatment of animals.
- Judges will have the final ruling.
- Junior Coed and Senior Boys Team Roping must stay in their respective divisions. You must rope with another contestant in your division. Senior Girls Team Roping can pick their partner who must also be a contestant. Senior Girls can tie on.
- The Rodeo Committee will utilize a points system with placing from 10 for 1st place and so forth to 1 point for 10th place for the all-around standings. If there is a tie, the winner will be determined by a flip of a coin.
- There will be no refunds unless you have a doctor's statement or Vet release; administration fee is not refundable.
- Contestants **MUST** be the age as of July 1, 2024.
- Roping events are catch as catch can.
- Ribbon roping roper must have hands on calf before the ribbon is pulled by the runner.
- For the Father/Daughter Rescue contest, rider (father) will ride from starting line. The rider will ride down the arena, ride around the barrel as they pick up their barrel partner (daughter) from atop the barrel and proceed back across the starting line. If the rider/partner falls off the barrel or the horse, the team will be disqualified. If the team does not pass around barrel, they will be disqualified. The team with the fastest time will win.
