GALLUP INTERTRIBAL CEREMONIAL EVENT

The first Gallup Inter-Tribal Ceremonial was held September 28, 1922, and primarily and uniquely features Native American and Indigenous diverse intertribal culture and art in both traditional and contemporary presentations. Thousands of Native American and Indigenous participants, some generational, have shared songs, dances, art, and culture. The event is held annually in August at the Red Rock Park, which is located 10 minutes east of downtown Gallup, New Mexico. This prestigious event is to serve, promote, and perpetuate Native American culture and crafts.

LITTLE MISS CEREMONIAL PAGEANT

The Little Miss Ceremonial pageant began in 2018, when the Gallup Inter-Tribal Indian Ceremonial hosted a Tiny Tot pageant for both boys and girls. The titles began with the Ceremonial Tiny Tot Princess and Ceremonial Tiny Tot Brave. In which they both represented together at youth functions and their tribal community events. Since 2021, the title has become Little Miss Ceremonial or Inter-Tribal Little Miss Ceremonial, focusing on providing the opportunity of sisterhood with Miss Gallup Inter-Tribal Indian Ceremonial Queen, to little girls of any tribe. Now, we provide this opportunity to any young girl with the initiative from the ages of 7-10 years, to represent alongside our Miss Gallup Inter-Tribal Indian Ceremonial Queen for one year.

Contestant Qualifications:

- Native American/Indigenous, born female, within the age of 7-10.
- Candidate must have reached the age of 7 years old on or before the first day of the competition and will not have reached the age of 11 years old when the pageant begins.
- Verifiable Tribal Affiliation.
- Knowledgeable in Tribal Traditions.

Competition Categories:

- Personality Photo
- Public Speaking
- Traditional Talent

(Judges will use a 5-point scale to rate contestants' criteria met in each category: 1 – lowest, 2 – fair, 3 – average, 4 – good, 5 – excellent, with no (.5) options.)

Prizes: Little Miss Ceremonial Crown, Shawl and Sash, prizes, and other donated miscellaneous gifts.

Description:	Contestants will have the opportunity to demonstrate knowledge of their culture by presenting a talent, skill, storytelling, dance, or song. The presentation will be a ticketed event in a stage setting with a live audience.
Location:	Pageant Tent at Red Rock Park, Gallup, NM
Length:	5-10 minutes – timer starts when contestant starts speaking or music begins.
Set up:	You may have parent help with stage set up for contestant items and props on/off stage.
Assistance:	On-stage assistance (for example, singers or dancers) will be limited to 3 people. Note: Helpers/Dressers/Relatives/Chaperones are not allowed in the backstage area.
Props:	 Contestants may use pre-recorded traditional music. Contestants will provide props to be used. Maximum number of props allowed: 8 Must not weigh more than 10 lbs each Must not be larger than 6 ft. x 4 ft.
