Parade Rules:

- All participants must be of Native American descent (exception only with written permission from Ceremonial Office)
- No motorized vehicles of any kind (exception from Ceremonial Office)
- Horseback riders and livestock will be placed at the end of the parade.
- All participants must dress in Native regalia, rodeo attire or uniform, **includes banner carriers and royalty chaperones**
- All participants are limited to one banner for identification; Royalty will be allowed only one adult chaperone.
- **NO POLITICAL ADVERTISING OR PROPAGANDA OF ANY KIND WILL BE HANDED OUT.**
- **NO CANDY OR ITEM TOSSING**

Parade line-up only accessible under Munoz Overpass

Must show valid credentials at Arnold and Historic 66.

Thursday Evening Parade:

- Assemble at Empty Lot East of Munoz Overpass
- Suggested arrival time 6:00pm
- Line up 6:00-6:45 pm

Saturday Morning Parade:

- Assemble at Empty Lot East of Munoz Overpass
- Suggested arrival time 7:30am
- Line up 8-8:45am

ROYALTY ENTRIES: There are only 14 slots available for the Thursday night parade and 14 slots available for the Saturday morning parade. Each royalty participant may choose which day they would like to walk in the parade.

Each entry will be allowed up to two banner carriers, who are required to be dressed in traditional attire.

Royalty under the age of 18 will be allowed one chaperone. Chaperones are also required to wear traditional attire.

(No t-shirts, tennis shoes, or standard dress clothes.)

Royalty over the age of 18 is not allowed a chaperone, requirement is to walk alone.

ROYALTY GROUPS: Royalty groups are permitted. Each member of the royalty group must pay a fee of \$150.00 and will be allowed to walk together.

VETERAN ROYALTY: Veteran Royalty will not be required to pay a fee when walking with a Veteran Group.
