

Gallup Inter-tribal Indian Ceremonial Tiny Tot Pageant Rules

The following rules and general information pertains to the 2018 Gallup Inter-tribal Indian Ceremonial Tiny Tot Pageant

- Two (2) title winners will be selected. One male and one female. The male will be crowned Gallup Inter-tribal Indian Ceremonial Little Brave and the female will be crowned Gallup Inter-tribal Indian Ceremonial Little Princess.
- The Little Brave and the Little Princess agree to participate in all Gallup Inter-tribal Indian Ceremonial parades; and attend the Friday night and Saturday night dance performances at Red Rock State Park and be introduced at each performance.
- Each contestant must provide with their contestant registration form a copy of their Birth Certificate and Certificate of Indian Blood.
- Contestants will be judged on traditional native attire and native talent.
- At the pageant, contestants will be announced and walk on the stage and model their traditional attire.
- Contestants must be able to walk on stage and perform their talent without parent involvement.
- Contestants or their parents may not contact the judges in advance of the pageant.
- Families and contestants are urged to promote good sportsmanship throughout the entire competition and backstage. Pageant representatives are always around. Bad sportsmanship is grounds for disqualification.
- Doors open at 4:30 p.m. Contestants should arrive no later than 5:00 p.m. **Please enter through the Event Center, 210 S. 2nd Street** (Contestant and **one parent**.) The competition will start promptly at 6:00 p.m. All spectators are required to pay a \$10.00 entrance fee.
- Seating begins at 5:00 p.m. Seating is on a first come, first serve basis. No sitting in area marked reserved. These seats are reserved for judges.
