### DIY NESTING BASKETS

#### **PATTERNS**

The nesting baskets patterns for tutorial video found on the DorindaStyle YouTube channel are listed below. If you want to make a size that is not listed below, cut your circle one inch larger than your finished basket. This will allow for a one-half inch seam. The formula for cutting the rectangle is 2x3.14xR. The radius (R) is one-half the circumference of the circle. Remember to add one-half inch on each edge of the rectangle to allow for a seam allowance. All seams are sewn to  $\frac{1}{2}$ .


Cut sizes for the rectangle fabric tops.

Cut stabilizer 1/2" smaller on each side and the bottom.

















THE DIAMETER OF THE CIRCLE SHOULD MEASURE 7" WHEN PRINTED



THE DIAMETER OF THE CIRCLE SHOULD MEASURE 6" WHEN PRINTED




THE DIAMETER OF THE CIRCLE SHOULD MEASURE 9 INCHES WHEN PRINTER
