DRAFT 3 was accepted & approved by board members. This budget includes the 2025 annual income of \$79,600 based upon Melrose Resolution 2025-1.

• EMI September invoice

The September invoice from EMI was received for \$2363.53. This included four (4) mowings & a fall fertilizer. Jackson sent an email to Matt Leiner (EMI representative that oversees Melrose) to address concerns about the invoice; this included the drought during September & EMI being seen on site but not mowing. Awaiting response.

• Uniform Deed Restrictions & Covenants (Jarod)

Jarod has finalized the uniform deed restrictions & PMI Scioto will work with them to produce a brochure for homeowners to use regarding DRs.

• Violation remedy date amendments\continuing fees

Jesse Kanitz is working on putting together a collection policy that allows Melrose HOA to move forward on violations that have not been paid. This includes a lein & possible foreclosure on a property.
