 - 1 property totaling \$675.00 is in bankruptcy
 - 1 property totaling \$1,380.00 is in foreclosure

- Violations
 - o Currently 12 violations

Yardmaster has mowed twice, edged beds and plans to mulch in the coming weeks. On their first mow, Yardmaster missed common areas but corrected this on the 2nd mow.
