Best Time to Visit Sedona

- **Winter (Dec–Feb):** Quiet, cold mornings, possible snow, great rates, peaceful hikes.
 - **Spring (Mar–Apr):** Wildflowers, mild temps, peak season, book early.
 - **Summer (May–Aug):** Hot, exposed, monsoon skies in July/August. Hike at dawn only.
 - **Fall (Sep–Nov):** Crisp evenings, Oak Creek Canyon fall colors, wine harvest.
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Permits & Safety Essentials

- Red Rock Pass or America the Beautiful Pass needed at many trailheads.
 - Parking fills by sunrise. Always have a backup hike.
 - Hydrate constantly, bring electrolytes.
 - Wear SPF, sturdy shoes, brimmed hat.
 - Avoid high points during lightning; watch for flash floods.
 - Leave No Trace: stay on trail, pack out trash, protect cryptobiotic soil.

- Village of Oak Creek – Quieter, golf, near Bell Rock.

 - **West Fork Trail:** Lush creek, great for summer.
 - **Soldier Pass:** Sacred Pools, sinkhole, caves.
 - **Bear Mountain:** Hard climb, huge views.
 - **Wilson Mountain:** Sedona's tallest summit.
 - **Fay Canyon:** Easy, shaded canyon.
 - **Secret Slickrock:** Short, family-friendly sunset pad.
