Another way to praise God is to use the attributes of God from Scripture. You could say, *Lord God, You are _____ (attribute of God), I praise you*. You can use the following list of attributes and then the Scriptures.

Awesome	You are so great, I praise you, <i>God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who is not partial and takes no bribe.</i> (Deuteronomy 10:17)
Beautiful	O Lord, you are Beautiful, I praise you. <i>One thing I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple.</i> (Psalm 24:5)
Creator	I praise you. <i>You are the Lord, You made the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. To all of them you give life, and the host of heaven worships you.</i> (Nehemiah 9:6)
Forgiving	I praise you. <i>Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless your holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and do not forget all his benefits who forgives all my iniquity, who heals all my diseases.</i> (Psalm 103: 1-3)
Eternal God	I praise you. <i>To the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, power, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.</i> (Jude 25)
Good	O God you are so good, I praise you. <i>Lord, you are good and forgiving, most merciful to all who call on you.</i> (Psalm 86: 5)
Heavenly Father	I praise you, my Heavenly father. <i>See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God; and that is what we are. The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him.</i> (1 John 3: 1)
Help	I praise you. You God are my <i>refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.</i> (Psalm 46: 1)
Joy	Jesus, You are my Joy, I praise you. <i>You are "the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.</i> (Hebrews 12: 2)
