Bio-Behavioral bases its selection process on the entire application package submitted through AAPJ; however, applicants who have met the following qualifications prior to beginning internship are considered preferred:

1. Some experience or special interest in working with OCD and Its Related Disorders
2. Must have completed at least two years of supervised externship/practicum experience involving provision of psychotherapy
3. Practicum experience utilizing evidence-based treatment methods, particularly CBT and DBT
4. A willingness and capacity to handle high-risk cases on an outpatient and intensive outpatient basis
