How should I vote?

- Vote absentee ballot (paper) and avoid machine voting.
- Vote early and take your absentee ballot to the Fayette County Elections
 Office clerk. Do not use the U.S. mail.

When can I vote? Key dates:

- 8/19 Earliest day to request absentee ballot for Nov. election
- 9/16 Earliest day to request absentee ballot for Dec. runoff election
- 9/17 UOCAVA (Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act) ballots mailed out for those already requested.
- 10/7 Absentee Ballots mailed out for those already requested

- Request early and vote early. Avoid machine voting.
