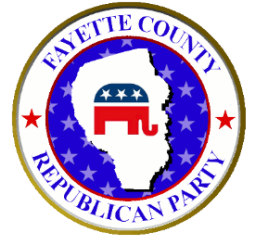


The Fayette County Republican Party: Press Release “We’re Not Gonna Take it Anymore!”

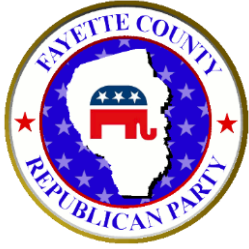
