So, I hope all my reimbursements for upkeep will keep going through. Snacks and water are important, we want our volunteers to be happy while giving of their time and talents.
- Moving the Christmas Party to the first Tuesday of December 5th, our newly elected City Councilwomen will be in City Council Meetings.
- We need to buy new push cards to represent the Republican Party. We currently have none. I propose we buy 1500. The proposed cost is **250** dollars.
