

2024 Fayette County Republican Convention

Resolution In Support of Enforcement of State Immigration Laws

WHEREAS, according to the latest estimates from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security only six states host more illegal aliens than Georgia, and

WHEREAS, Conservative and Republican values demand that we honor the rich tradition of legal immigration into the United States by refusing to ignore or reward illegal immigration, and

WHEREAS, Georgia's taxpayer-funded Registered Apprenticeship Program and Dual Enrollment program both include illegal aliens as participants and beneficiaries and act as reward magnets to additional illegal immigration into our state, and

WHEREAS, Innocent Georgians are being murdered, raped, kidnapped and molested by illegal aliens in senseless and fully preventable crimes, and

WHEREAS, in 2018 Governor Kemp campaigned on making criminal aliens a priority in his administration, ending sanctuary city policies and to track and deport "criminal illegals" by pushing legislation through the state legislature that would create a public database of "criminal illegals", and

WHEREAS, Due to the betrayal by the Biden administration, states must act to insulate themselves from the organized crime that is illegal immigration;

WHEREAS, the Georgia General Assembly is considering House Bill 301, with language to enforce a 2009 state law that outlaws so-called sanctuary cities and counties, and HB 1105, The Georgia Criminal Alien Track and Report Act of 2024;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fayette County Convention of the Georgia Republican Party that we urge the Governor of Georgia and the state legislature to endeavor to take action to insure unapologetic and vigorous enforcement of state laws aimed at illegal immigration and that all Republican elected and appointed officials in Georgia shall adopt a pro-enforcement attitude and clear policies that make Georgia an unwelcoming place for illegal aliens, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of the Fayette County Republican Party and/or Convention Secretary is directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, President Pro Tempore, Speaker of the House, Speaker Pro Tempore, Third and Sixth District Republican Leadership, and the State of Georgia Republican Party and to encourage them to affirm, adopt, and enact this resolution by law, policies, and/or adoption of this resolution.
