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Notes

- Reports are not reviewed with the same urgency as incidents. Please note incidents on this Poll Watcher Report on page 3 below but please be sure to **submit the incidents immediately**. Incidents must come directly from the person who witnessed them. We are not submitting these for you from this report.
- Note any machines that are down and ask the Manager what the issue is and ask for the count on any BMD station that is closed or any scanner that is offline.
- **IMPORTANT: Tally your #s before you leave the precinct.** The scanner total should never be higher than the BMD total (you can't scan more ballots than you print). If it is, either you missed a BMD, or one was taken off-line.
- It is common for BMD counts to be higher than Scanner counts due to spoiled ballots. Please ask the Manager for the reason and note the details. The numbers must reconcile.
- **Early Voting Only**: If you are at a Drop Box location for the evening shift, please stay to see the transfer of Absentee Ballots and record the count.
- **Election Day Only:** Record time ballot counting begins and the time ballot counting completes on report. Generally describe how count was conducted in your person notes. If time to count exceeds 30 minutes, complete incident form but do not file with protect the vote but include with your report as to the issues in counting.

Reporting:

Return your reports to the Fayette County GOP office at a later date. Please eMail, Text a copy of your report, or complete a web form close after your shift. The web form will report a subset of the numbers you reported on your report. You may use the QR code below to open the web form.

Opening Shift: complete a web form for opening, and another for mid day when you depart. Evening Shift: complete a web form indicating mid-day, another for 5:00pm and one for closing.

You may also complete multiple mid-day reports throughout the day. This data will be used to determine voting patterns. Mid-day reports do not require BMD or Poll Pad numbers as voters will be present hindering your ability to collect those numbers.

The web form does not replace the shift report, but it does eliminate the need to send the picture of the report. Do not use your phone inside the poll to report these numbers. If you choose not to do the web form, I will have to manually enter the numbers from your photographed report into the web form and submit for you.

The information from these reports will be used to compare against the Secretary of State's counts of people voting and validate no votes occurred between closing and opening. It is important to file on the day you watch.
