Parade Participant,

Thank you for your Pioneer Day Parade entry. We are excited to have you in our parade! Headquarters will be at the Centennial Stake Center. Enter from the east off Main Street onto 9th South. Your entry number will be at the table at the Headquarters. We have a few rules we would like you to follow.

- 1. Check-in time. We will call you a few days prior to the parade with your check in time. Please enter from Main Street onto 9th South. Parade line up: We will have a spot reserved for you at the Stake Center.
- 2. Keep it moving! As the parade proceeds make sure that you stay with the pace. Limit stops on performance to less than 40 seconds.
- 3. Candy: Throwing candy is permitted only by walkers who go to the curb. No throwing candy from moving floats/vehicles due to the danger of the children coming out in the middle of the road to retrieve it. No throwing anything other than candy.
- 4. Absolutely no feet dangling from trailers or trucks. Remember to keep things safe for everyone.
- 5. Your float or entry can be no taller than 16 feet (power line height).
- 6. If your entry includes horses, you must have someone following you to clean up the waste.
- 7. Please use the dispersion route at the end of the parade. **Do not try to go back through the original parade route**. People on your float should be dropped off at the stake center where you began.
- 8. When you leave the parade staging area be sure to clean up garbage.
- 9. Please bring water with you. We may have a very warm morning. Plan to have lots of fun! Porta-Johns will be set up at the stake center.
