Discipleship Ministry Center Purpose

Basic Steps in Discipleship

Seekers **Believers Disciples** Disciple-Makers


Defining the Steps of Discipleship

- Seeker A person that is seeking to know the Lord.
- Believer A person that has come to know the Lord as their Savior.
- Disciple A person who follows the principles of Jesus Christ.
- Disciple Maker A person who works to get others to follow Jesus Christ.

Who's Who?

- Community Those individuals who are outside of the church.
- Crowd Those individuals in the church but have not made a commitment to join.
- Congregation Those individuals who have joined the church and make up the church body.
- Committed Those individuals who take an active role in church activities.
- Core Those individuals who are in leadership positions within the church.

Who's Who Graphically



Two Areas of Discipleship Training

- * Discipling of New Members
 - a. Retention of individuals who have joined the church
 - b. Objective is to keep them coming back
- * Discipling of Existing Members
 - a. Get them to grow deeper and stronger in their relationship with Christ

Discipleship Defined

 General Disciple - A pupil or follower, who accepts and helps, promotes and spread his masters teaching. (Webster's Dictionary)

• **Biblical Disciple** - Those who follow *Jesus*. Refers to the Apostles (Matt. 10:1, 11:1), but more often to Christians. (Acts 6:1, 2,7)
