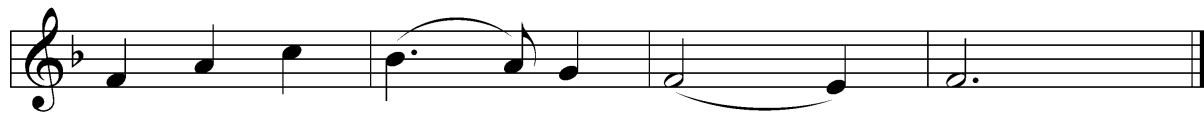

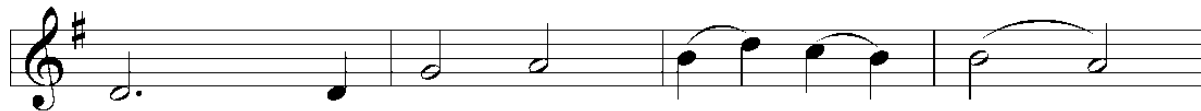

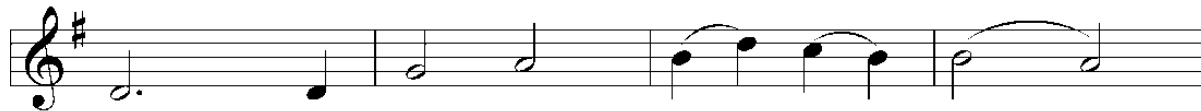

Shepherd of Love The Church is holy believers, the little sheep who hear the voice of their Good Shepherd. They hear and follow the voice that says to them “***I am the good Shepherd. The good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.***” (John 10:11) They hear the voice of Jesus when He says, “I laid down My life for you so that you might belong to Me forever. I washed you from your sin in the still and living water of Baptism. I lead you to green pastures of My forgiveness, where you can lie down and rest in My tender mercy spoken to you. I also spread a table before you in the presence of your enemies.
