

The Old Testament:

Jeremiah 23:16-29

Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you, filling you with vain hopes. They speak visions of their own minds, not from the mouth of the LORD. They say continually to those who despise the Word of the LORD, 'It shall be well with you'; and to everyone who stubbornly follows his own heart, they say, 'No disaster shall come upon you."

For who among them has stood in the council of the LORD to see and to hear His word, or who has paid attention to His word and listened? Behold, the storm of the LORD! Wrath has gone forth, a whirling tempest; it will burst upon the head of the wicked. The anger of the LORD will not turn back until He has executed and accomplished the intents of His heart. In the latter days you will understand it clearly.

"I did not send the prophets, yet they ran; I did not speak to them, yet they prophesied. But if they had stood in My council, then they would have proclaimed My words to My people, and they would have turned them from

their evil way, and from the evil of their deeds. Am I a God at hand," declares the LORD, "and not a God afar off?

"Can a man hide himself in secret places so that I cannot see him?" declares the LORD.

"Do I not fill heaven and earth?" declares the LORD.

"I have heard what the prophets have said who prophesy lies in My name, saying, 'I have dreamed, I have dreamed!' How long shall there be lies in the heart of the prophets who prophesy lies, and who prophesy the deceit of their own heart, who think to make My people forget My name by their dreams that they tell one another, even as their fathers forgot My name for Baal? Let the prophet who has a dream tell the dream, but let him who has My word speak My word faithfully. What has straw in common with wheat?" declares the LORD.

The Epistle: Acts 20:27–38

For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole counsel of God. Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which He obtained with His own blood. I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish everyone with tears. And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. I coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my necessities and to those who were with me. In all things I have shown you

that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how He Himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive."

And when he had said these things, he knelt down and prayed with them all. And there was much weeping on the part of all; they embraced Paul and kissed him, being sorrowful most of all because of the word he had spoken, that they would not see his face again. And they accompanied him to the ship.

Matthew 7:15–27

[Jesus said:] "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus you will recognize them by their fruits.

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of My Father who is in heaven. On that day many will say to Me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and cast out demons in Your name, and do many mighty works in Your name?' Mt 7.15-23 I never knew you

Grape vine wreath When the Lord issues a warning, it is serious. "Beware of false prophets," They are everywhere. Do not be so naive as to be fooled by sheep's clothing. Of course they look nice, do nice things, and mean well.

The false prophets who dress in sheep's clothing preach good works. They seek to get bad trees to bear good fruit. But look

what happens: "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your Name, cast out demons in Your



name, and done many wonders in Your Name?'And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness."'

Calling "Lord, Lord," prophesying in His Name, casting out demons in His Name, and performing many wonders in His Name are all good works. They seem like the fruit that good trees produce. What better evidence of a prophet than his performing wonders like Peter and Paul or casting out demons? But those things are not enough. Not everyone who does them enters into heaven. Bad trees cannot bear good fruit. Even when their fruit appears to be good, it is not. Those without faith—despite their works and intentions — are cast out. God demands faith. Justice requires that you be cut down and cast into the fire. Your works are not good enough. They cannot save you.

No one comes to the Father except through the Son. There is no other Name under heaven by which men are saved. Not even everyone who is baptized, everyone who calls "Lord, Lord" enters into the kingdom of heaven. Who enters? Only those who do the will of the Father. The will of the Father is not good works. The will of the Father, of the true God, is not calling upon Him, casting out demons, and performing wonders in His Name. The will of the Father is that the Son drink the Cup of His Wrath and shed His own Blood that men might drink that Life Blood in the Cup of Blessing and live. Jesus says, "Drink of it all of you for the remission of sins". That is His will. That is the effect. There bad trees are declared good as only God is good, for there bad trees are grafted into the good Vine, Jesus. His works, His faith, His submission to the Father's will all counts for them. He welcomes them to Himself in Divine mercy and grace. From the crown of thorns comes wine to make glad the hearts of men, to give them joy and peace that words cannot express, which surpasses all knowledge, which is found only in the forgiveness of sins and the free bestowal of a clean conscience which we did not deserve.

The kingdom of heaven is here by grace and for your eternal good. Come and eat what the Lord gives and receive strength and faith to face the enemy and carry on where He has placed you.
