The Holy Gospel:

John 16:5–15

But now I am going to Him who sent Me, and none of you asks Me, ‘Where are you going?’ But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send Him to you. And when He comes, He will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment: concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see Me no longer; concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

“I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. The Dove is the symbol of the Holy Spirit

Even in the midst of trials, suffering, grief, and hardship, you can sing to God, who promises that these sufferings are temporary and tailor made even for your good. You are the Church that God has planted in this world as His pilgrim people, in whose heart He has placed hope, and in whose mouth He has placed a new song, about how God who so

loved the world that He gave His only Son.

The Holy Spirit now comforts and helps you by taking all of what is Christ's and declaring to you the things that are to come. He gives you Holy perspective through the Word of Scripture and through the Sacraments of Baptism, Absolution, and the Lord's Supper. This perspective shows and delivers your coming eternal deliverance. The perfect righteousness of Christ is yours. All that the Father has is Christ's; and all that Christ has is given to you by the Holy Spirit. Eternal life is yours. It is a divine promise and fact—it IS coming. The Lord will return to take you to be with Him. So, beloved of God—sing with joy. Sing with all the saints and angels in heaven, and come to the feast of your salvation.
