Joshua 1:9 Learning Center Uniforms

Our uniforms for all students will consist of polo shirts, pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, polo dresses, and jogger pants (not sweatpants), and our red school spirit t-shirt. We are an action-based learning school, so we want our kids to be comfortable and able to move.

Here are a few guidelines to help you while shopping:

- The kind of material is not an issue, just as long as all items are solid colored with no design or labeling on the front of them.
- All polo shirts and polo dresses must be either red, black, or white in color. We will wear our red school spirit t-shirt on Spirit Days and Field Trips.
- The style of all bottoms for both girls and boys does not matter (such as: pleated, not pleated, pockets, no pockets), but they <u>must</u> be either black or khaki in color (no white). Please make sure all skirts, shorts, dresses and skorts are no shorter than 3 inches above knee.
- Our main goal is that everyone has on khaki, black, white, and red as our primary colors. <u>Do NOT buy navy colored items.</u>
- Hoodies, sweatshirts, cardigans, or sweaters must be red, black, or white in color.
 Hoodies/sweatshirts purchased from the <u>Joshua 1:9 Spirit Wear store</u> are also allowed. Uniform attire must be worn underneath hoodies, sweatshirts, cardigans, or sweaters.
- For Kindergarten 8th Graders: Crocs are not permitted on days when your child has P.E. class.
 If your child wears crocs on P.E. class days, parents will be called and asked to bring another pair of shoes to school. Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten students must wear tennis shoes each day to school.
- Hats are not allowed except while outside at recess or P.E. Hats are <u>not</u> allowed to be worn inside the school building at any time.
- Hair must be neat and kept out of the way of eyes.
