



Brevard History Lesson

TITUSVILLE, FLORIDA — Law enforcement technology has come a long way since the 1940s when the Titusville Police Department's (TPD) main means of communicating with patrol officers was a flashing red light mounted on a tall pole near S. Washington Avenue and Julia Street.

In a recent Facebook post by TPD that included a vintage image of Titusville Police Chief W.T. "Dinky" Brown, Verda Blackburn, George Johns, W.J. "Bo" Bohannon, John D. Threlkeld and Robert Green, historians said that around 1948, TPD officers watched for the flashing red light which could be seen from anywhere between the north and south city limits.

"If the light was flashing, the patrolman knew he was needed somewhere, so he headed to the nearest phone to find out where," said the TPD post. "Because there was no switchboard, the officer called the telephone operators who took messages for them."

Later, as part of an expansion of the department in 1951, a telephone was installed at Cutter's Drugs at the corner of S. Washington Avenue and Julia



Street. Employees would take messages for the patrolmen and if important they would find the officer and deliver the message. At night after the store closed, the patrolmen would use the phone on the pole again.

"There was very little crime back then, maybe two or three burglaries a month, and very few people bothered to lock the doors to their homes," said the TPD post.

Neighborhood Recipes—Instant Pot Dijon Pork Chops

Ingredients:

- 2 Cups of Chopped Carrots
- 1 bag of mini potatoes
- 1 1/2 cup of chicken broth
- 5 to 6 pork shops (Boneless)
- 1 Tbsp of oil.

Sauce Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cups of apple juice
- 1/4 cup of brown sugar
- 1 Tbsp of Dijon Mustard

Directions:

1. Turn Instant Pot (IP) to Sauté Hot.

- 2. Add oil and wait 1 minute.
- 3. Add pork chops and cook 2 to 3 minutes per side.
- 4. Remove Pork Chops.
- 5. Turn off Sauté.
- 6. Add potatoes, 1 1/2 cup of chicken broth
- 7. Place a trivet on potatoes.
- 8. Add chopped carrots and pork chops.
- 9. Set IP to High Pressure for 15 minutes, then let it naturally release for 15 minutes.
- 10. Sauce
- II. Combine ingredients and heat to glaze.


