General Barn Rules:

Welcome to Goslin Nix Equestrian Center. We are hopeful that you will enjoy everything that we have to offer for both you and your horse. In order to keep everyone safe and happy while at our facility, we have created a few guidelines that we ask you to follow:

1. Drive SLOWLY on the property. Please do not exceed 5 mph. Also if gate is closed please call us to let you in, do not mess with gate motor or gate and please **DO NOT** drive thru our yard at our residence.
2. NO ONE including children are to be in or around the pool without a GNEC staff member present.
3. All scheduled lessons must be cancelled **24 Hours** ahead of time. You will be charged for all services **NOT cancelled 24 hours** in advance
4. No Smoking anywhere on property
5. No dogs allowed on property
6. Do Not leave your horse unattended
7. Always use a lead rope when leading your horse
8. Please return all equipment, supplies, and tack to the appropriate place when you are finished with them. Everyone is responsible for his / her tack
9. Please **CLEAN UP** after yourself and your horse. Put all trash in trash cans, and all manure in manure buckets. If trash is left and GNEC staff has to pick it up there will be a **25-dollar** charge to the responsible individual. Please remember this is where GNEC staff lives so please pick up after yourself.
10. Young children not participating in a lesson **must be supervised** by a parent or guardian at all times. Children may not run and make noise in or around the barn and arenas. If there is a non-riding child, sibling, or friend who needs a place to play, please ask one of the instructors.
11. The barn is open Tuesday – Friday 8am to 6pm, Saturday 8am to 3pm, Monday & Sunday by appointment only.
12. We reserve the right to use any pictures taken on our property or as a part of our barn in any publicity efforts we may incorporate. If you do not want GNEC to use any pictures of you or your child, please let management know.

LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE

This Voluntary Liability Waiver and Release Agreement is made and entered into this Date _____, 20____, by and between Participant or if Minor Participant's Parent And Goslin Nix Equestrian Center at 10227 Pecan Hollow Rd Magnolia, TX 77354.

"Participant.." In addition to the individual Participant identified above, the term "participant" in an equine activity has the meaning as defined in Chapter 87, Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code, sec 87.001 ("aperson who engages in an equine activity, without regard to whether the person is an amature or professional or whether the person pays for the activity or participates in the activity for free").

2. "Equine Activity." The Term "equine activity" has the meaning as defined in Chapter 87, Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code, sec 87.001, and includes, but is not limited to, the activities in which Participantengages with respect to the riding, handling, training, instruction, showing, and boarding of horses, ponies, or other equineanimals, whether at astable, trail riding,, horse show, competition, or other equestrian event.

3. WARNING

UNDER TEXAS LAW (CHAPTER 87, CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE), AN EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES.

4. Inherent Risks. Participant, and if Participant is a minor Participant's parent or guardian, understand that there are risks inherent in dealing with horses, ponies, and other equine activities. For example, Participant understands that some **but not all** of the inherent risks Include:

- A.** The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to a persons on or around it.
- B.** The unpredictability of an equine animal's reaction to sounds, sudden movements, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals.
- C.** That there may be certain land conditions or hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions.
- D.** The possibility of a collision with another equine, animal, person, or object.
- E.** The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death or loss to the person or property of Participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the participant's ability.

5. Examples. Participant, and if Participant is a minor Participant's parent or guardian, further understands that examples of the equine activities encompassed within the scope of this voluntary waiver and release agreement include **but are not limited to**

- a.**Riding, lessons, showing, competitions, trailriding, exhibitions, and the like, in any equine discipline including dressage, reining, and eventing.
- b.**Training, teaching, instructing, and evaluation activities, both of the rider or handler and the equine.

- c. Riding, handling, showing, or competing an equine belonging to another, without regard to whether the owner receives money or other things of the value for its use.
- d. Routine care, feeding, and handling of the equine, including veterinary and farrier care.
- e. Transportation, loading, and unloading of equines.
- 6. **Voluntary Waiver and Release:** With full understanding of the inherent risks involved in equine activity, some of which have been described in Paragraph 4 above, Participant, and if Participant is a minor Participant's parent or legal guardian, voluntary agrees to waive, release, and hold harmless Goslin Nix Equestrian Center from all tort and civil liability arising from or related to participation in equine activity. This agreement to waive, release, and hold harmless includes not only Goslin Nix Equestrian Center, but its officers, employees, agents, apprentices, and independent contractors, whether they be trainers, veterinary personnel, farriers, equine care providers, and the like.
- 7. **Protective Headgear Warning:** Participant, and if Participant is a minor Participant's parent or legal guardian acknowledge the he / she / they have been fully warned and advised by Goslin Nix Equestrian Center that participant should purchase and wear an ASTM certified equestrian riding helmet while riding and handling equines.
- 8. **Governing Law:** This voluntary waiver and release agreement is made and entered into, and shall be governed by and interpreted, under the laws of the State of Texas. If any provision of this Agreement is found to be null, Void, or voidable under the applicable law, the remainder of the Agreement shall survive intact.
- 9. **Final Agreement:** Participant, and if Participant is a minor Participant's parent or guardian, agrees that he / she / they have been given sufficient time to read, understand, and ask questions, if any, concerning the Nature and scope of this voluntary waiver and release agreement.
