1. Shall be clean, safe, sanitary, and in good repair at all times for the safety and well-being of clients. (Reg. 80087 a)	()	()	()	()
2. All outdoor and indoor passage-ways, stairways, inclines, ramps open porches and other areas of potential hazard shall be kept free of obstruction. (R 80087 c)	()	()	()	()
3. Swimming pools shall have at least a five-foot fence around them or shall have a pool covering inspected. Fencing shall be so constructed that it does not obscure the pool from view, and is self latching at the top of the gate. (R 80087 f-1)	()	()	()	()
4. Above ground pools, shall be made inaccessible when not in use by removing or making the ladder inaccessible or erecting a barricade to prevent access to decking (Incl. Spa and Jacuzzi). (R 80087 f-2)	()	()	()	()
5. First Aid and/or CPR, when applicable will be accepted by the Licensing Agency to meet the requirements in Section 83032, through submission, to the agency, of a copy of a certificate of training.	()	()	()	()
6. No more than two children shall share a bedroom including members of the licensee's family. (R 83087 b-1)	()	()	()	()
7. Children over 5 and of the opposite sex not to share the same bedroom. (R 83087 b-2)	()	()	()	()

8. No room commonly used for other purposes shall be used as a bedroom. Such rooms include but not limited to halls, stairways, unfinished attics or basements, garages, storage areas, sheds or similar detached buildings. (R 83087 b-3-A) () () () ()
9. No bedroom shall be used as a public or general passage-way to another room. (R 83087 b-4) () () () ()
10. Except for infants, children in placement shall not share a bedroom with an adult. (R 83078 b-5) () () () ()

FIXTURES AND FURNISHINGS

1. All window screens shall be in good repair and be free of insects, dirt and other debris. (R 8088 b) () () () ()
2. Fireplaces, and open-faced heaters shall be made inaccessible to clients to ensure protection of the clients safety. The use of a fireplace screen or similar barrier will meet this requirement. (R 80088 c-1) () () () ()
3. Shall provide lamps or lights as necessary in all rooms and other areas to ensue comfort and safety. (R 80088 d) () () () ()
4. Shall maintain at least one toilet, sink, and tub or shower in the home. (R 83088 b) () () () ()
5. Shall provide each child with an individual bed which is equipped with a clean comfortable mattress, clean linens, blankets, and pillows as needed. (R 83088 c) () () () ()
6. Linens shall be changed at least once per week or more often when necessary. (R 83088 c-2) () () () ()

7. Beds shall be arranged to allow easy passage between beds and easy entrance into the room. (R 83088 c-3) () () () ()
8. Shall provide each infant with a safe and sturdy bassinet or crib, appropriate to the child's age and size. (R 83088 d) () () () ()
9. Bunk beds of more than two tiers shall not be used. (R 83088 e) () () () ()
10. Bunk beds shall have railings on the upper tier to prevent falling. (R 83088 e-1) () () () ()
11. Children under 5 years of age or those who are unable to climb into or out of the upper tier unassisted shall not be permitted to use the upper tier. (R 83088 e-2) () () () ()
12. Shall provide toys, games, books and recreational and educational materials for the children, based upon their ages, and mental and physical development. (R 83088 f) () () () ()
13. Each bedroom shall have a portable or permanent closets and drawer space to accommodate the child's clothing and personal belongings. (R 83088 g) () () () ()
14. Shall have telephone service on premises. (R 80073 a) () () () ()

STORAGE

1. storage for Poisons shall be locked. (R 80087-1) () () () ()
2. Storage of firearms and other dangerous weapons shall be locked. In lieu of locked storage of firearms, the licensee may use trigger locks or remove the firing pin. Firing pins shall be stored and locked separately from firearms. (R 80087 h-1, 2) () () () ()

3. Ammunition shall be stored and locked separately from firearms. (R 80087 h-3) () () () ()
4. Disinfectants, cleaning solutions, and other items which could pose a danger if readily available to clients shall be stored where inaccessible to clients. (R 80087h) () () () ()
5. Pesticides and other similar toxic substances shall not be stored in food storerooms and kitchen areas. (R 80076 a-15) () () () ()
6. Soaps, detergents, cleaning compounds or similar substances shall be stored in areas separate from food supplies. (R 80076 a-16) () () () ()
7. All food shall be protected against contamination. Contaminated food shall be discarded immediately. (Reg 80076 a-16) () () () ()
8. Refrigeration available for food. All foods or beverages shall be stored in covered containers. (R 80076 a-14) () () () ()

SUPERVISION

1. If all children are involved in out-in-home programs, such as school or day care, the licensee shall be permitted to be regularly absent during those hours. (R 83964 c-1) () () () ()
2. When the licensee is absent from the home while children are present he/she shall provide for supervision of the child by a responsible adult unless otherwise agreed to by the licensing agency. (R 83064 c-2) () () () ()

FOOD SERVICE

1. There shall always be fresh perishable and nonperishable food in the home in a () () () ()

quantity to meet the needs of the next three meals and the between meal snacks.
(R 83076 b, 80076 a-1)

2. All home canned foods shall be processed in accordance with standards of the University of California Agricultural Extension Service. Home canned foods from outside sources shall not be used. (For foster children only)(R 80076 a-11) () () () ()
3. Powdered Milk shall not be used as a beverage but shall be allowed in cooking and baking. Raw milk, as defined in Division 15 of the California Food and Agricultural Code shall not be used. Milk shall be pasteurized. (R 80076 a-9) () () () ()
4. Food serviced to the child shall be of the same quality as that served to other family members.(R 83076 c) () () () ()
5. Infants younger than seven months shall be held during bottle feeding. (R 83076 f) () () () ()
6. Whenever children in placement eat at home it is expected that they will have their meal with family members.(R 83076 h) () () () ()

MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Individuals driving the vehicles have valid drivers licenses. (R 80074 c) () () () ()
2. The manufacturer's rated seating capacity of the vehicles shall not be exceeded.(R 80074 b) () () () ()
3. Motor Vehicles used to transport clients shall be maintained in a safe operating condition.{R 80074 c) () () () ()
4. Motor Vehicles used to transport clients must be properly insured. () () () ()

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5. When transporting children in a private motor vehicle the licensee shall secure the children as specified below:
- (a) Infants shall be secured in a car seat designed for infants(R 83074 b-1) () () () ()
 - (b) All children between two and four years of age and all children who weigh less than 40 pounds, shall be secured in a car seat or harness designed for such children. (R 83074 b-2) () () () ()
 - (c) Children over four years of age and who weigh over 40 lbs who are able to sit unassisted shall be secured in the vehicle's regular seat belt/harness. (R 83074 b-3) () () () ()

HEALTH RELATED

- 1. Emergency and disaster plan centrally located.(R 80023, 80075 f) () () () ()
- 2. Medication shall be kept in a safe and locked place that is not accessible to clients.(R 80075 i-1) () () () ()
- 3. First aid supplies shall be maintained and be readily available in a central location in the home. (R 80075 e) () () () ()
- 4. First aid supplies shall include at least the following: Current edition of the approved first aid manual, sterile first aid dressings, bandages or roller bandage adhesive tape, scissors, tweezers, thermometers, and antiseptic solution.(R 80075 e-1) () () () ()
