Control is mandatory. You may not refuse. If you have a medical condition that is affected by the chemicals, contact our office in order to make other arrangements. Refusing pest control is considered a lease violation.


Please make sure all areas are accessible, including bedrooms and bathrooms, and remember that pest control also serves as housekeeping inspections.

Please remember that treating cockroaches with over the counter spray is counterproductive to our professional services. Do not use products such as Raid or other sprays. It is also important to refrain from collecting plastic shopping bags as they create a nesting environment for roaches and mice.

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
Furnace Filters

This routine maintenance of your furnace is mandatory and you do not have to be home while they are there. No appointments will be made.
