## **Attention!**

Kirksville Housing Authority - The Kirksville Housing Authority is required to review all policies and regulations on a regular basis.

During our most recent Board of Commissioners meeting, the Board reviewed and approved a revision to our Schedule of Repair Charges. This is a document that explains how we charge for services such as having an extra key made, lock outs, and repairs for tenant caused damage.

Our tenants receive a copy of this document at the time of move-in as

part of their 'Move-in Handbook Packet". We also keep a copy posted on the bulletin board in the West entry way.

You may review the Schedule of Repairs Charges that are posted in the office at anytime during normal

business hours. You may also request a copy for your own records by calling ahead and picking it

up at the front office.

## **EEEWWW!!**

Kirksville Housing Authority - One man's trash is not always another man's treasure. Especially if the trash or treasure is infested with cock roaches or bed bugs.

Recent days have proven to us that no matter how many times we tell our tenants that items purchased from any used "second hand store" need to be inspected by our

> Maintenance Foreman BE-FORE taking the items into your unit. This is a preventative measure to minimize the risk of infestation.

This rule also applies to items taken from dumpsters or even household items that have been "set out" after a tenant vacates.

Our security cameras captured many of our current tenants "pilfering" through abandoned furniture and other household belongings that were known to be infested and taking them home.

For those that participated, please know that should that kind of careless behavior cause an infestation inside your unit, you can be charged for the eradication.

### **Pest Control**

Kirksville Housing Authority - Pest Control for July will take place on Thursday, July 10th for apart-

ments #101 through #132 and all of Devlin Place

August Pest Control will be Thursday, August 7th for apartments #133 through #164 and all of Devlin Place.

Please remember that Pest Control is mandatory. You

may not refuse. If you have a medical condition that is affected by the chemicals, contact our office in order to make other arrangements. Refusing pest control is considered a lease violation.

All areas must be accessible, including bedrooms

and bathrooms, and remember that pest control also serves as housekeeping inspections.

As always, do not use over the counter pest control chemicals that interfere with our treatments.

We will be using a "bait" for the next few months as opposed to a spray.

This will look like a gooey substance that



will be applied around cabinet door hinges.

Please DO NOT wipe or wash it off. It must remain there in order for it to work.

## **Celebrate!**


Kirksville Housing Authority - It's time to celebrate the birth of our Great Nation!
