Kirksville Housing Authority - Each year, our elected officials pass budgets for our country that affect all of our lives. Those budgets include funding that support our housing programs. The proposed budget for 2026 is recommending cuts to some housing programs.

The Kirksville Housing Authority maintains membership in an organization called the National Association of Housing And Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO). They work diligently to advocate for our housing programs and keep us informed about actions that Congress is proposing.

Each year, delegates from Housing Authorities all across the country travel to Washington DC and make our way to Capitol Hill. We meet with our Representatives and Members of Congress to tell our stories and advocate for our programs. Our

elected officials need to know how crucial affordable housing is for our families.

You have the opportunity to be heard. You can visit NAHRO's website and click on the "Advocacy and Policy" tab. Then click "Action Alert Center" and "Advocate Now". You can then click on "Act" and enter your information. The letters are already written and will automatically be sent to your Representatives and, yes, even the President. Those letters can be edited to add your own thoughts if you choose.

You will find a second button that says "Tell". You can click on that and tell your story. Tell Congress why Affordable Housing is so incredibly important and what it means to you.

Tell your story and let your voices be heard!

September Pest Control will be Thursday, September 4th for apartments #165 through #200 and all of Devlin Place.

Please remember that Pest Control is mandatory. You

may not refuse. If you have a medical condition that is affected by the chemicals, contact our office in order to make other arrangements. Refusing pest control is considered a lease violation.

All areas must be accessible, including bedrooms

and bathrooms, and remember that pest control also serves as housekeeping inspections.

As always, do not use over the counter pest control chemicals that interfere with our treatments.
