A preventative chemical application was placed on the greens. There have been some warm days that have shown some growth but we cannot mow anymore for two reasons. First reason is the chemical application would be wasted if we mowed it off and we do not have any more chemicals to make another application. The second reason is to help with winter stress it's good to let the grass grow a little longer than normal greens height. All in all it was a great year.
