The Golf Shop & Clubhouse are Closed on Mondays with the exception of Holidays and Golf Outings. The Course will open on Monday's for walking at 2:00 PM.

Hours are subject to change based on weather!

Hours of Play

FCC doesn't operate on tee times unless mandated to do so (like 2020). The first start time is 8:00 am Tuesday - Sunday April 15th - September 30th. Starting times may vary during colder months (March, April, October & November) based on weather and frost delays.

The Club is closed on Mondays throughout the year, however the golf course will open for Member walking & private carts at 2:00 PM. The first tee is reserved on Tuesday mornings at 9 am for the White Tee Game and Ladies , Wednesday at 1 pm for the Moyer Group, Wednesday at 4 pm for the Men's Game, Thursdays until 11 am for the Ladies Association, Fridays at 1PM for Men's Game, Saturday at 9 am for Member Groups, and Sunday at 9 am for Points Game.

Practice Range

The Practice Facility will open at the same time the Golf Shop opens and will close at 7PM Tuesday - Friday, 5:30 PM on Saturday, and 4PM on Sundays to allow ample time for staff to clean up the range.

Guest Policies

Members are encouraged to bring guest to play and enjoy the Club. Guest are permitted to play at FCC up to three (3) times per year excluding any guest days. Members are required to register all guest in the Golf Shop prior to play. Members are responsible for ensuring guest are following all policies and procedures while at the Club.

Dress Code

PROPER GOLF ATTIRE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PLAYERS

Non-collared shirts, tank tops, halter-tops, cutoffs, sweat pants, tennis or other athletic shorts, and bathing suits are not permitted on the golf course or practice facilities.

For gentlemen, shirts with collars or mock collars and sleeves, slacks and golf shorts are considered proper attire.

For ladies, slacks, capris, skirts, skorts, dresses, blouses and shirts with or without a collar or sleeves are considered proper attire.

Leagues/Groups

Fremont Country Club offers several different Leagues/Groups that can accommodate many levels of play. It is our goal to integrate as many Members into the Club as possible. Our Leagues/Groups are a great way to meet other people, have fun, socialize and build friendships in a friendly and relaxed setting.

White Tee Group/Tuesday Morning

A group of Members on Tuesday mornings, where all play is from the White Teeing Ground. Starting in May the group will play between 9 am-9:30 am. In order to play, you will have to let the Golf Shop know no later than 30 minutes before play begins.

FCC Ladies Association/Thursday Morning

The FCC Ladies Association consists of ladies that pay annual dues for a variety of events. The Association plays every Thursday morning starting in May. All league play consist of both individual and team events with prize pools. The Association has roughly 22 weeks of play which include events such as Club Championship, "MAJORS" as well as the annual FCC Ladies Invitational. The Association is open to all FCC Members. It is a fun and relaxing atmosphere with great Members where you can meet new people and have FUN!

Men's Nine Hole Scramble/Tuesday Evenings

One of the most enjoyable events at FCC. The Two-Man Scramble on Tuesday evenings starting in May. You select your partner and compete for both Gross and Net Prizes. There is an entry fee associated with the Nine hole scrambles.

Men's Groups/Wednesday Afternoon, Friday Afternoon, Saturday & Sunday Morning

All of the Men's Groups are paired by the Golf Shop. In order to play with any of the groups on these days, Members are required to sign-up 30 minutes prior to start times. On Wednesday, Friday and Saturday the Men's Blue Group (White tee players as long as age & handicap equal 80 or more) play various team formats, entry fee required. Also on Saturdays, the White Tee Group will all play from the white teeing Ground. The Ladies Group will have a couple groups that play as well and on Sunday morning there is a Men's Points Game.

Hole-In-One Club

The Hole-In-one Club is designed to reward a Member (Non-Social) who gets a Hole-In-One at FCC between April 1st - October 31st that is witnessed by another person.

All Golf Members are auto-enrolled in the Hole-In-One Club. All Members of the Hole-In-One Club are billed \$2 when they are first enrolled and billed another \$2 on their statement when a Hole-In-One is made by a Member of the Hole-In-One Club. A Member can opt out of the Hole-In-One Club if they choose to do so upon request. Members who opt out will not receive any of the privileges of the Hole-In-One Club.

Golf Shop

The FCC Golf Shop is a full service shop with the best pricing for all in-line merchandise from all the top vendors. The staff is happy to place any special orders upon request if we don't have what you are looking for. FCC Golf Shop offers a Buyer's Club that cost \$65 annually, which includes all hard goods at 20% over cost + shipping and all soft goods at 30% over cost + shipping. To enroll in the Buyer's Club, contact any staff Member in the Golf Shop.

The golf Shop can also accommodate all corporate and large group orders!

Handicaps

Northern Ohio Golf Association

Fremont Country Club is a Member of the Northern Ohio Golf Association (NOGA). To allow our Members to participate in the many tournaments throughout our district, we must adhere to all NOGA rules and regulations. The NOGA is part of the World Golf Handicap system and Handicaps are computed daily during the golf season. These procedures will also help the Golf Staff and Golf/Handicap Committee establish fair handicaps for Club events.

White Tee in Club Events

White tees will be available in all Club events for all men whose age + handicap are equal to or greater than 80.

Maximum Score of Net Double Bogey

Starting in 2020 under the new World Golf Handicap System, the maximum score any golfer can post is a score of Net Double Bogey.

Posting Scores

After completing 9-holes or 18-holes the player is responsible to enter his/her adjusted score on the GHIN App or the handicap computer located in the Golf Shop. In addition, scores from other courses must be entered through the GHIN App or the handicap computer. If you have any questions concerning any of the above procedures, please ask one of the Golf Professionals for assistance. To be eligible to post any score you must play with at least one other person.

All rounds of at least 13 holes or more are also to be posted. If you play at least 13 holes, the remaining uncompleted holes, for handicap purposes shall be recorded as par plus any handicaps strokes that you are allocated to receive on the unfinished holes.

We are aware the Club is to be used and enjoyed by the Members and the above mentioned rule will not apply if a golfer enjoys a few holes while not playing under the Rules of Golf (playing multiple shots and/or practicing on the course). The handicaps posting procedures are designed to account for all 9 or 18-hole from the beginning of the season to the end of the golf season. April 1st - October 31st. Scores from November 1st - March 31st can not be posted for handicap purposes.
