The Greens Section

- Mother Nature has aided in leaf removal. The oaks, lindens and pear trees are holding on to their leaves as long as possible. If there are any more warm days available and the ground is firm enough, more mulching and blowing will be done.
- Seed is germinating under covered areas on the greens.
- All Tee Markers will be removed from tees and painted for next season.
- Course conditions will continued to be monitored daily for allowing carts on course.
- In last months newsletter, there was a small write up on trees. Once the ground firms (freezes solid) some of the dead trees will be removed. Several trees on the course are affecting the greens and need attention. All tree removal (except dead trees) will be approved by the Board and taking to membership before any decision is made.
- The maintenance shop is in a steady flow of equipment and cart service maintenance preparing for the 2020 season.
