Dear Members,

The Club has been fortunate to obtain some free dirt from the building of the new schools in Fremont. The board would like to thank Rob Hall for making this happen. The dirt will be used to fill in some bunkers that have been a maintenance nightmare. The two bunkers that will be filled in are the fairway bunkers on Hole #6 and Hole #7. The bunkers will be filled in using a shallow layer of dirt and top soil, basically leaving the contour that is currently there. There might be some additional mounding to help with drainage and water runoff. These two areas will be mowed at rough height.

There will be some trees removed from the course this Spring (dead trees). It was also approved to grind the stumps that have been left from previous tree removal and that is being completed this Spring as some stumps have already been ground up!

The Club is looking at purchasing new patio furniture this season and will be getting rid of all the existing tables, chairs and umbrellas. There is also a new awning going to be installed on the South side entrance to the Clubhouse.

The Club currently has four weddings scheduled for the 2020 season and several other inquires. As most are aware, the outside events are a huge part of the recent success at FCC! We need to keep the Club in great shape and continue to make updates when needed. Thank you for the continued support.

One last thing! The Capital Campaign that was presented last season was a huge success and it hasn't been stopped. The heavy topdressing that may have been an inconvenience for some during the winter months has so far proven to be a huge benefit to the greens. It was a semi mild winter for snow and the sand acted as a insulated blanket. This was the first year for trying the sand blankets and next winter I will do it again and adjust rates as needed. The beginning of the month the flagsticks will return to the greens. I would love to be completely thawed out before any play is allowed to avoid the risk of shearing roots on partially frozen turf. I do keep in mind everyone's cabin fever and eagerness to get back on the course. Once the ground is fit enough we will begin to start mowing and rolling. Cart usage will also be closely monitored until the ground firms up completely. The 2019 grounds staff all plans to return again for the 2020 season. Howard the mechanic is wrenching away on finalizing winter equipment maintenance. A group of volunteer members got together at the end of February and did a course clean up day. Thank you to all that showed up! Stumps are being ground throughout the course. 2020 projects will be the filling of #6 and #7 fairway bunkers. These areas will be shaped to drain water, still offer a challenging lie, and be mowed at normal rough height. I can't wait to get back out on the course and hope to see everyone soon!
