## The Greens Section

- Greens Aeration will begin October 14th and 15th
- Bad spots on #1,#3,#6,#12,#13 greens will be cored, sanded, seeded
- Tees, Approaches, Fairways will be aerified when time allows and before the snow flies
- Bathrooms on course will remain closed as irrigation repairs are being done.
- Grub control timing was tough this year. The spring was very wet and there were minimal signs of beetles throughout the summer. The chemicals put down controlled most of the grub activity. There are several areas of skunk/raccoon damage but they are only picking and not rolling big areas of sod up. I will continue to monitor this to see if another chemical application will be needed.
- Please continue to fix ball marks on greens, fill divots with sand, and keep carts 30 feet from greens.
- The leaves have begun to fall. Very minimal right now but should increase as we get deeper into the month. We only have one tractor in operation which has the rough mower attached to it. As the leaves fall I will try to balance blowing and mulching with the tractor.
- The new greens mower has arrived. The adjustments will be tinkered with over the next few weeks to see what its limitations are.
- The end of the season is quickly approaching so I want to give a shout out to my staff. The three of them plus Denny have worked extremely hard to provide everyone a great place to play golf. Having the very minimum to work with they got the job done. Thank you guys for your hard work!
