



Follow up of Colonic Polyps

Type of Polyps	Recommendation
<input type="checkbox"/> Hyperplastic	Repeat examination in 7 to 10 years if asymptomatic (Except those with family history)
<input type="checkbox"/> Adenomatous*	
<input type="checkbox"/> Less than three	
all low grade dysplasia	Repeat examination in 5 years if asymptomatic
all less than 5mm in size	
<input type="checkbox"/> 3 to 10 polyps	
<input type="checkbox"/> Polyp size more than 1cm	Repeat examination 3 years later if asymptomatic
<input type="checkbox"/> Moderate / High grade dysplasia	
<input type="checkbox"/> "Villous" subtype	
<input type="checkbox"/> More than 10 polyps	Repeat examination within 3 years if asymptomatic
<input type="checkbox"/> Other concerns	Examination within 6 months

***First degree relatives of those having adenomatous polyps should consider early screening**
