



INTRODUCTION

First and foremost, I want to specially welcome you to this life-changing National Youth and Young Adult Conference taking place right here in Virginia Beach, VA. As you already know, the theme for this year's conference is Greater Works (John 14:12) and it is my belief that you have come here with great expectations in your heart. We thank God for the great and mighty things He did in our lives and midst at the last conference in Philadelphia, PA (Come, Holy Spirit, 2022). The LORD has promised good to us at this year's Greater Works 2024 conference, and I hope you have come with your heart prepared and ready to take delivery of all that the LORD has for you. The LORD has assured us that the last conference is a downpayment for the glory that He is going to release at this year's conference. If you think the last conference was great, I advise you to fasten your spiritual seatbelt for a more glorious experience in His presence at this conference. This is a conference like no other. There have been preparations at different levels of leadership in this ministry to ensure that we do our part so that God can do what He wants to do in our lives. It will be very irresponsible of anyone to think that he or she does not have a role to play in actualizing what God has promised. It is true that

I God is not a man, that He should lie, and He makes good on His promises (Numbers 23:19); but, we must also make sure that there is no iniquity or wickedness in our midst (Number 23:21).

The scripture says, "3 Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. 2 And the Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. 3 Then Moses said, "I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn." 4 So when the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am" (Exodus 3:1-4, NKJV). Moses had a fire in his spirit to rescue his brethren from the Egyptians, but he went about it the wrong way (Exodus 2:11-13). He wanted to use his physical power and might to deliver his people but they turned against him (Exodus 2:14). He failed woefully and became a fugitive after Pharaoh sought to kill him (Exodus 2:15). Forty years later, when the fullness of time came, God showed up at mount Horeb to bring Moses into the destiny that He had for him. At this time, Moses never had to struggle to do the work by his own might or power because the Spirit of God took over: "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the Lord of hosts." (Zechariah 4:6). Moses returned back to Egypt with the Rod of God in his hand (Exodus 4:20) and delivered the children of Israel from the claws of their Egyptian slave masters with signs, wonders, and a strong hand: "20 You have set signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, to this day, and in Israel and among other men; and You have made Yourself a name, as it is this day, 21 You have

brought Your people Israel out of the land of Egypt with signs and wonders, with a strong hand and an outstretched arm, and with great terror; 22 You have given them this land, of which You swore to their fathers to give them—"a land flowing with milk and honey" (Jeremiah 32:20-22).

Likewise, God has come in this year's conference to bring many into the glorious destiny He has for them. It is going to be a time of divine pruning for fruitfulness, divine empowerment for maximum productivity, and divine dressing for the next level (John 15:1-2). God is going to pour out His Spirit again and commission many into their divine ordination (Joel 2:28-29). This gathering is going to witness divine separation for divine assignments and missions (Acts 13:1-3). Just as Moses went out that fateful day and did not return home the same, you also will not remain the same again after this conference. It doesn't matter if this is your first time or seventh time coming to the National Youth and Young Adult Conference, the truth is that you are not leaving this conference the way you came. God is making a deposit of grace that will turn you into a sign and a wonder (Isaiah 8:18). God is going to empower you to go out there and do greater works for Him after this conference (John 14:12). People might have looked down on you or told you how dumb or foolish they think you are. That is what they say, but not what God is saying about you. The question is: "Whose report will you believe?" (Isaiah 53:1). (John 14:12-14). So, for the duration of the conference, let your faith be strengthened and trust God for everything He has for you. He will empower you to do great and mighty things for Him after this conference. He picked ordinary people like you and I in the Bible and used them to do extraordinary things for Him. Do you believe God can do the same with you? Yes, He will, if you have faith in Him.
