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# JUDY PEARLSTONE: PROJECT BACKPACK FOUNDER, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & PRESIDENT

Judy Pearlstone is the creator and original organizer of Project Backpack. She began the project as a local social service project of NA'AMAT USA (an international service organization) and made the first distribution of backpacks to a local police department in 1999.

Judy created Project Backpack solely with the mission to help children in the St. Louis area. The children served are the silent victims of domestic violence. The organization provides emergency services by furnishing area police departments, social service agencies, domestic violence shelters and Department of Family Services workers with backpacks for children who are removed from their homes usually with nothing but the clothes on their backs.

Under Judy's direction, the project quickly mushroomed and grew to become an independent entity. She brings a wealth of not-for-profit organizational experience to her leadership of Project Backpack. She has served as a member of the National and Midwest Boards of NA'AMAT USA and as President of its St. Louis Council. She continues to serve as a member of the NA'AMAT Board in St. Louis.

Judy has been involved with helping victims of domestic violence for more than a decade, starting with crisis training through ALIVE, Inc. (Alternatives to Living in Violent Environments). As a retired teacher at the H.F. Epstein Hebrew Academy, Judy has in-depth understanding of children and their needs. She received her BA from Washington University in St. Louis and her MA in Education from Webster University.
