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
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MEANING OF SOCIAL CHANGE

- Social change is way human interactions and relationships transform cultural and social institutions over time, having a profound impact of society. ...
- Society is the net-work of social relationship. Hence, social change obviously implies a change in the system of social relationship.

DEFINITION OF SOCIAL CHANGE

- Sociologists define social change as changes in human interactions and relationships that transform cultural and social institutions.
- According to Gillin and Gillin We may Define Social Change as Variation from the Accepted modes of life.
- <u>Kingsley Doris "By social change is meant only</u> <u>such alternations as occur in social organization</u> <u>i.e. the structure & functions of society".</u>
