Old Testament (witness)

Psalm 9:7-8, the LORD shall endure for ever; He's prepared <u>His throne</u> for judgment. And He shall judge the world with righteousness; He shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

New Testament (witness)

- 2 Timothy 4:1, I charge thee therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at His appearing and His Kingdom:
- 1 Peter 4:5, ...give <u>account</u> to Him (Jesus Christ) that is ready to <u>judge</u> the <u>quick and the dead</u>.
- Hebrews 9:27, As it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the
 Judgment ...

<u>Judgment Seat (reserved for the just)</u>

~Accountability~

- 2 Corinthians 5:10, For <u>we all must appear</u> before the <u>judgment seat of</u>
 <u>Christ</u>, that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to what he hath done, whether it be good or bad.
- 2 Timothy 4:8, There is laid up for me a crown of righteousness which the Lord, the righteous Judge, shall give me on that Day
- 1 Peter 4:17, For the time has come that <u>judgment</u> must begin at the house of God. And if it first begin with <u>us</u>, what shall <u>the end be of those</u> <u>who obey not the Gospel of God</u>? (saved & unsaved will be judged)

White throne Judgment (reserved for the unjust)

God will **reserve** the unjust unto the **Day of Judgment** to be punished. - 2 Peter 2:9b

Revelation 20:11-15

- 11, And I saw a great white throne and Him that sat on it ...
- 12, And I <u>saw the dead</u>, small and great, <u>standing before God</u>, and the books were opened; and another book was opened, the Book of Life. And the dead were **judged** out of those things which were written in the books, <u>according to their</u> works.

- 13, And the <u>sea gave up the dead</u> which were in it; and <u>death and hell delivered</u> <u>up the dead</u> which were in them; and they were <u>judged</u> <u>every man according to</u> their works.
- 14, And <u>death and hell were cast into the lake of fire</u>. This is the <u>second death</u>.15, And whosoever was <u>not found written in the Book of Life</u> was cast into <u>the lake</u> of fire.

Insert (the fallen angels)

- Isaiah 14:12-15 (Lucifer and 1/3 of the angels)
- 2 Peter 2:4, For if God spared not <u>the angels who sinned</u>, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness to be <u>reserved</u> unto <u>judgment</u>;
- Jude 1:6, And the <u>angels who kept not their first estate</u>, but left their own habitation (Genesis 6:1-2), He hath <u>reserved</u> in everlasting chains under darkness unto the <u>judgment of the great Day</u>

The Final Destination (eternal damnation)

Revelation 21:8, But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burn with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

The Evangelism commission (charge)

- 2 Corinthians 5:11, Knowing therefore the <u>terror</u> of the Lord, we <u>persuade</u> men; ...
- Matthew 28:19, Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit
