On January 23, 2024, the Board of Directors ("Board") of Belvedere Municipal Utility District (the "District") held a regular meeting within the boundaries of the District at the Belvedere Amenity Center, 17400 Flagler Drive, Austin, Texas. A copy of the notice of meeting along with associated certificates of posting are attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

The roll was called of the members of the Board, to-wit:

At the beginning of the meeting, all of the Directors were present, thus constituting a quorum of the Board. All Directors who attended voted on all Items that came before the Board. Other attendees included Megan Norris, P.E., and McKenna Sanders, EIT with Quiddity Engineering; Bob West with West Davis & Company; David Klein, Attorney, and Fred Castro, Paralegal, with Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C. ("Lloyd Gosselink"); and Keith Milkiewicz with the Belvedere Homeowners Association (the "HOA").

- 1. <u>Call meeting to order and establish a quorum</u>. Director Koerner called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. He announced that all Directors were present, and therefore a quorum of the Board was in attendance.
- 2. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary regarding Preservation Ranch Development, including but not limited to, construction activities within the District.</u> Directo Koerner introduced this Item. Directors Koerner and Clifford stated that they had nothing to report at this time regarding this Item.
- 3. <u>Receive public comments</u>. There were no public comments.
- 4. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action to approve the minutes of the January 7, 2024 special meeting.</u> Director Koerner introduced this Item, and a copy of the minutes is attached hereto in **Exhibit "B"**. Director Clifford moved to approve the minutes of the January 7, 2024, special meeting, as presented. Director Ubertini seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0. The Board then took up Item 6.

- 5. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary concerning reports from the District's Bookkeeper and Finance Committee, including:</u>
 - a. Payment and ratification of invoices;
 - b. Coordination on bookkeeping matters;
 - c. TexPool investments; and
 - d. Reimbursement of costs to Belvedere HOA pursuant to the Joint Use and Maintenance Agreement.

Director Koerner introduced this Item and presented a revised Bookkeeper's Report and cash sheet, consisting of the list of invoices and additional documentation concerning other bookkeeping matters, all of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit "D"**. He requested that the Board add a check, payable to Peter Golde for the renewal of the District's GoDaddy website hosting fee for \$434.67. Director Koerner stated that he would talk with the District's Bookkeeper to set up the website under a District account. Next, Director Clifford requested that a check be added, payable to Quiddity Engineering for \$6,837.50 for engineering services through December 29, 2023. Director Koerner requested that, per the Bookkeeper's Report, the Board (i) ratify the payment of the prior invoices, (ii) approve the payment of new invoices, and (iii) the addition of checks to Peter Golder and Quiddity Engineering. Director Ubertini moved to ratify the payment of the invoices paid since the Board's last regular meeting and approve the payment of current invoices and approval of additional checks to Peter Golde and Quiddity Engineer. Director Clifford seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0. The Board then took up Item 7.

- 6. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action to approve the audit for the period ending September 30, 2023</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item. Mr. West addressed the Board and described the results of the audit, provided as <u>Exhibit "C"</u>. Mr. West notified the Board that his firm rendered a clean opinion on the financials and then proceeded to summarize the audit, highlighting: (i) what the District accomplished during the year; (ii) the balance sheet; and (iii) the five-year comparison of the general fund, revenue, and expenses. Director Koerner moved to approve the audit as presented and to authorize Lloyd Gosselink to file the audit with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. Director Clifford seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0. The Board then took up Item 5.
- 7. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action regarding reports from the District liaison to the HOA and from the HOA liaison to the District</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item. Director Koerner and Mr. Milkiewicz stated that they had nothing to report at this time.
- 8. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary to adopt Order Calling Directors Election and authorize publication of notice; (Discutir, considerar y adoptar medidas que sean necesarias para adoptar una orden de elección de directores y autorizar la publicación del aviso)</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item. Mr. Klein stated that Directors Ubertini and Clifford's terms were expiring and up for reelection in May 2024 and that the deadline for receiving a candidate's application for a place on the ballot was 5:00 p.m., Friday, February 16, 2024. He stated that in the event the Directors Election is uncontested, the Board will follow the procedures for the election of unopposed candidates established by the Texas Election Code and cancel its May 4, 2024 Directors Election. A copy of the Order Calling Directors Election is attached hereto as **Exhibit "E"**. Director Clifford moved to adopt the

- Order Calling Directors Election, as presented, and authorized publication of the notice of same. Director Sciaraffia seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0.
- 9. Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary to authorize the execution of election agreement with Travis County; (Autorizar la ejecución del acuerdo de elección con el Condado de Travis). Director Koerner introduced this Item. Mr. Klein noted that the District typically engages Travis County to conduct the District's Directors Elections, if contested. He added that by contracting with Travis County for election services, the District would be sharing in such costs with all other political subdivisions in Travis County utilizing the County to conduct their May 4, 2024 elections, memorialized under one joint election agreement with the County. Mr. Klein stated that the County has not provided a finalized election services agreement yet because critical election-related deadlines had not yet passed and the County is unsure of the political subdivisions that will ultimately request their services and of the election polling places required. recommended that the Board authorize the Board President to review and approve an election services agreement with Travis County and authorize the Board President to execute a joint election agreement with political subdivisions in Travis County, should the need arise, when the final agreement becomes available. Director Clifford moved to authorize the Board President to execute an election services agreement with Travis County and joint election agreements with political subdivisions in Travis County, if necessary. Director Ubertini seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0.
- 10. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action regarding the adoption of District Drainage System Issue Resolution Guidelines</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item. Director Clifford requested that this Item be taken up with the next Agenda Item. This Item was discussed in conjunction with Item 11.a.
- 11. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action regarding the improvement, maintenance, and repair of existing and future assets owned or maintained by the District, including, but not limited to:</u>
 - a. Report from the District's Engineer;
 - b. Issuance of Notice of Violation concerning culvert/ditch work at 8316 Verde Mesa;
 - c. Update on culvert/ditch work along Springdale Ridge;
 - d. Playground maintenance work update; and
 - e. Trail maintenance.

Director Koerner introduced this Item, a copy of the Engineer's Report is attached as **Exhibit "F"**. Director Sciaraffia provided an update on his latest efforts to address the matter concerning the property owner at 8316 Verde Mesa who installed rocks and plants in the ditch in front of his property without first seeking District approval. This issue also concerns the possibility that the slope of the ditch is incorrect either due to improper grading or placement of the culvert which impairs the proper flow of rainwater runoff. Discussion ensued that it was the Board's understanding that (i) some corrective action has been taken by the homebuilder to address the slope of the ditch problem and (ii) such homebuilder had informed the District's Engineering Subcommittee that he felt that he had completed all corrective actions related to the slope of the ditch and any other issues was the property owner's responsibility. Director Sciaraffia stated that the District Engineer

would not opine on the work needed to address the slope without a survey being conducted first. Director Clifford stated that the District's Engineering Subcommittee issued this property owner a Notice of Violation on December 28, 2023. After discussion, Director Sciaraffia agreed to approach the homeowner one last time before getting legal counsel further involved.

Next, in conjunction with Items 10 and 11.a., Ms. Norris stated that she had worked with the District's Engineering Subcommittee to come up with a set of District Drainage System Issue Resolution Guidelines and presented a set of Guidelines for the Board's consideration, attached as **Exhibit "G"**. Director Clifford stated that this set of Guidelines was to be used by the Board for reference purposes and was not a part of any Policy previously adopted by the Board. Director Koerner moved to adopt the District Drainage System Issue Resolution Guidelines, as presented. Director Ubertini seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0.

Then, as to the playground maintenance work, Director Clifford advised that the replacement parts had been received and installation was expected to take place in the next week or so. She noted that the District would then purchase "kiddie mulch" from another company to complete the maintenance work.

Next, a discussion ensued regarding the District Engineer's role in maintenance of the trails. Ms. Norris committed to review any prior work done by Quiddity regarding an ongoing inspection plan and to make recommendations with regards thereto at the next meeting.

- 12. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action on future meeting schedules</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item and suggested that the next Board meeting be held at 6:00 PM at the Belvedere Amenity Center on March 19, 2024. There was a consensus of the Board to hold the meeting at that time and location and they directed the District's consultants to take the steps necessary to schedule such a meeting.
- 13. <u>Adjournment</u>. Director Clifford moved to adjourn the meeting. Director Scaraffia seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0. The meeting adjourned at 7:12 p.m.








Summary of Past Activities: Quiddity walked all trails in February 2020. In the summer of 2020 a maintenance plan was drafted. Quiddity presented the design proposal for the Amenity Center Trail in June 2020. An agreement with Sunscape began in October 2020. In addition to the routine quarterly site visits, Sunscape also addressed erosion concerns in December 2020, worked on winter storm cleanup in March 2021, and addressed trail washout areas in June 2021. In January 2022, Quiddity inspected the existing trails and no maintenance needs were identified. The Amenity Center Trail was constructed later in 2022. In March 2023, Sunscape performed maintenance at the trails including work at a low water crossing and addressing racking on the masonry sections of the trails.

OPTION	DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES
1	Quiddity to inspect all of the trails within the District twice each year- once in the spring and once in the fall. Inspections would include identifying any drainage patterns that could be negatively impacting the trails as well as checking existing drainage elements for conveyance and potential maintenance needs. Quiddity to summarize identified maintenance needs and potential improvements to enhace the existing trails. Quiddity to verify trail width and trail material (flagstone vs. crushed granite) upon initial inspection.
2	Quiddity to prepare a feasibility report for the improvement of the existing natural trail which extends from the west side of Rollins Drive to the Amenity Center. This trail could be converted to crushed granite or flagstone. All applicable regulatory requirements would need to be followed, including any verifications of impervious cover limits or water quality.
