On April 15, 2025, the Board of Directors ("Board") of Belvedere Municipal Utility District (the "District") held a special meeting within the boundaries of the District at the Belvedere Amenity Center, 17400 Flagler Drive, Austin, Texas. A copy of the notice of meeting along with associated certificates of posting are attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

The roll was called of the members of the Board, to-wit:

At the beginning of the meeting, all the Directors were present, except Director Sciaraffia, thus constituting a quorum of the Board. All Directors who attended voted on all Items that came before the Board. Other attendees included Meagan Norris, P.E., and McKenna Sanders, EIT with Quiddity Engineering; David Klein and Danielle Lam, Attorneys, Fred Castro, Paralegal with Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C. ("Lloyd Gosselink"); and Fred King, a District resident.

- 1. <u>Call meeting to order and establish a quorum</u>. Director Koerner called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. He announced that a quorum of the Board was in attendance.
- 2. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2025 regular meeting.</u> Director Koerner introduced this Item, and a copy of the minutes presented to the Board is attached hereto in <u>Exhibit "B"</u>. Director Ubertini moved to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2025, regular meeting, as presented. Director Webster seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.
- 3. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action concerning the resignation of Director Sciaraffia</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item. Mr. Klein presented a copy of Director Sciaraffia's letter of resignation, provided as <u>Exhibit "C"</u>. Director Koerner moved to accept Director Sciaraffia's letter of resignation. Director Ubertini seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.
- 4. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action to appoint a new director</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item. Mr. Klein advised that Mr. King, a District resident, was interested in appointment to the Board of Directors and that Mr. Klein's office had vetted him as a

candidate to fill the vacancy and found that he was qualified to serve. Mr. Klein opined that no further due diligence was needed to be pursued by the Board before considering the appointment of Mr. King as a director. Director Koerner moved to appoint Mr. King to the Board of Directors. Director Parker seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 4-0. Next, Director King recited his Statement of Officer and Oath of Office, administered by Mr. Castro, a Notary Public.

- 5. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action concerning the election of new officers.</u> Director Koerner introduced this Item. Director Koerner moved to keep the current slate of officers the same and to appoint Director King to the open office of Secretary/Treasurer. Director Ubertini seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0. After discussion, Director Koerner requested that an item be placed on the Board's next regular meeting agenda to reconstitute the District's various subcommittees and to appoint members to same.
- 6. Receive public comment (three (3) minutes per speaker; but any person providing public comment through a translator is limited to six (6) minutes, unless the District uses simultaneous translation equipment in a manner that allows the Board to hear the translated public testimony simultaneously with the speaker). There were no public comments.
- 7. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary concerning reports from the District's</u>
 Bookkeeper and Finance Committee, including:
 - a. Payment and ratification of invoices;
 - b. TexPool investments; and
 - c. Reimbursement of costs to Belvedere HOA (HOA) pursuant to the Joint Use and Maintenance Agreement.

Director Koerner introduced this Item. Director Ubertini presented the Bookkeeper's Report and cash sheet, consisting of the list of invoices and additional documentation concerning other bookkeeping matters, all of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit "D"**. After discussion, Director Webster moved to authorize the bank transfers, ratify the payment of the invoices paid since the Board's last regular meeting, and approve the payment of current invoices, as presented in the Bookkeeper's Report. Director Koerner seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0.

- 8. Discuss, consider, and take action regarding reports from the District liaison to the HOA and from the HOA liaison to the District. Director Koerner introduced this Item and announced that Director Ubertini had been appointed as the new District liaison to the HOA. He mentioned that he and Director Ubertini would be working together with the HOA on various projects, including maintenance of the mailbox kiosk. Additionally, Director Koerner stated that the HOA plans to expand and improve the front entrance to the subdivision. Ms. Norris pointed out that any work conducted within the right-of-way must be approved by Travis County, which holds jurisdiction over those matters. Furthermore, Director Koerner noted that the HOA will be applying mulch within the common areas, with the costs being shared equally between the HOA and the District.
- 9. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary concerning the use of the upper pond for potential fire protection purposes.</u> Director Koerner introduced this Item and explained that the Board had asked the District's Engineer to assess the feasibility of using the upper pond

as a water source for firefighting activities. Ms. Norris clarified that this pond is a designated wet pond specifically designed to capture and hold stormwater for extended periods. This design allows for the removal and degradation of pollutants through natural processes, which is essential for effective stormwater management. The management of stormwater falls under the jurisdiction of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, which oversees the implementation of a comprehensive Stormwater Management Program aimed at controlling the quality of discharges within the State, and changes to the pond would need to be approved by ("TCEQ"). Ms. Norris expressed her opinion that using the upper pond as a water source for firefighting is not a feasible option. The Board discussed the feasibility of using the upper pond as a water source for firefighting, including concerns about access to the pond for emergency service vehicles and having to install a pond liner. No action was taken on this Item.

- 10. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action regarding the posting of information on the District's website.</u> Director Koerner introduced this Item. He reported that several comments had been received from the community regarding the website, specifically highlighting how cumbersome it was to navigate. Director Koerner noted that Director Parker had volunteered to assess the District's website to identify potential improvements. During her review, Director Parker found that information was difficult to locate and was presented in an inconsistent manner throughout the site. She stated that she would continue to evaluate the website and implement improvements where possible.
- 11. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action regarding regulation, improvement, maintenance, and repair of existing and future assets owned or maintained by the District, including, but not limited to:</u>
 - a. Report from the District Engineer;
 - b. Drainage facilities, including, but not limited to:
 - c. Trail maintenance.

Ms. Norris stated that the home builder had completed the drainage ditch improvements at 8708 Springdale Ridge Cove, and that Director Koerner communicated to the resident on March 31, 2025 that the District approved of the improvements. Next, Ms. Norris reported that her firm had inspected the District's trails on February 25, 2025, and documented the findings in her engineer's report attached hereto as **Exhibit "E"**. She stated that several culverts were observed to have blockages from leaves, vegetation, dirt, and rocks. Ms. Norris recommended that the Board consider having the culverts cleaned, including other maintenance activities to address areas of concern. Director Ubertini requested that Ms. Norris review the contract with Sunscape Landscaping to determine what maintenance activities could be performed under their existing contract.

- 12. <u>Receive update on 2025 Legislative Session</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item. Mr. Klein provided a summary of recently filed legislation, noting potential impacts on the District.
- 13. <u>Discuss, consider, and take action on future meeting schedules</u>. Director Koerner introduced this Item and suggested that the next Board meetings be held at 6:00 p.m. at the Belvedere Amenity Center on June 24, 2025, August 26, 2025, and September 16, 2025. There was a

consensus of the Board to hold the Board's next three meetings on June 24, 2025, August 26, 2025, and September 16, 2025, and they directed the District's consultants to take the steps necessary to schedule such meetings.

9. <u>Adjournment</u>. Director Ubertini moved to adjourn the meeting. Director King seconded the Motion and the Motion passed unanimously, 5-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:03 p.m.

This FIRST AMENDMENT TO LANDSCAPING SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Amendment") effective as of the date last signed (the "Amendment Effective Date"), is made and entered into by and between Sunscape Landscaping, LLC, attn.: Jesse Trevino, P.O. Box 342228, Austin, TX 78734 ("Sunscape Landscaping") and the Belvedere Municipal Utility District, Attn: David Klein, Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C., 816 Congress Avenue, Suite 1900, Austin, TX 78701 ("Client"). Sunscape Landscaping and the Client are each a "Party" and collectively, the "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Sunscape Landscaping and Client are parties to the Landscape Services Agreement, dated September 14, 2020, contemplating the provision of landscape services, defined as the "Services," by Sunscape Landscaping to the Client; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement to add the Amenity Center Trail to the locations where Sunscape Landscaping will provide the Services to Client.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and other good and valuable consideration contained herein, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

AMENDMENT

- 1. <u>Additional Services</u>. The Parties agree that the Services provided by Sunscape Landscaping to Client shall also be performed on the service road on the Client's amenity center property that is used to access the Belvedere swimming pool (the "Additional Service"). Client shall pay Sunscape Landscaping \$127.00 per month for such Additional Service. The total monthly cost for the Services, including the Additional Service shall be \$1,021.97 (which is the sum of \$894.85 + \$127.00). The Service Cost and Total Cost of "\$894.85" per month listed in Exhibit B of the Agreement is hereby replaced with the updated amount of \$1,021.97, and the total annual cost for the Services on Exhibit B shall be updated accordingly.
- 2. <u>Recitals</u>. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Amendment for all purposes.
- 3. <u>Defined Terms</u>. The defined terms in the Agreement shall have the same meaning in this Amendment, except as otherwise provided in this Amendment.

- 4. <u>Effect of Amendment</u>. Except as set forth in this Amendment, the Agreement is unaffected and shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms. In the event of any inconsistency or conflict between the provisions of the Agreement and this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment will prevail and govern. All references to the Agreement or in any exhibit or schedule thereto shall hereinafter refer to the Agreement as amended by this Amendment.
- 5. <u>No Third-Party Beneficiaries</u>. Nothing expressed or implied in this Amendment is intended, nor shall be construed, to confer upon or give any individual or entity other than the Parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns any rights or remedies under or by reason of this Amendment.
- 6. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. The Agreement, as amended hereby, constitutes the full and entire understanding and agreement between the Parties regarding the subject matter hereof and thereof and supersedes and cancels all prior agreements, negotiations, correspondence, undertakings, and communications of the Parties, oral or written, with respect to such subject matter.
- 7. <u>Authority and Representations</u>. Each Party executing this Amendment warrants and represents that the individual executing this Amendment on its behalf has the authority and power to execute this Amendment for the entity on behalf of which he or she executes this Amendment.
- 8. <u>Counterpart Execution</u>. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be, for all purposes, deemed to be an original, and all such counterparts shall together constitute and be one and the same instrument. A facsimile or other electronic copy of a signature, and a counterpart transmitted electronically (e.g., by fax, email, text, or similar means), will be deemed to be and will have the same force and effect as an original signature for all purposes.

LANDSCAPING SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN BELVEDERE MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT AND SUNSCAPE LANDSCAPING, LLC

This is a Landscaping Services Agreement (the "Contract") between Sunscape Landscaping, LLC, P.O. Box 342228, Austin, TX 78734 ("Sunscape Landscaping") and the Belvedere Municipal Utility District ("Client"), Attn: Stefanie Albright, Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C., 816 Congress Avenue, Suite 1900, Austin, TX 78701 for landscaping services (the "Services" as further described herein) to be performed within the boundaries of the Belvedere Municipal Utility District in Travis County, Texas ("Premises"). The Premises are more specifically detailed on the map attached as **Exhibit A**.

Terms of Service:

- Sunscape Landscaping shall provide the Services detailed in this Contract below at the rates quoted herein for a term of 36 months commencing on October 1, 2020. Additional services required by the Client may be appended to the Contract at negotiated rates in effect at the time the services are added. Client shall grant Sunscape Landscaping access to the Premises at mutually agreed upon times for performance of the Services.
- 2. Sunscape Landscaping shall invoice Client on a monthly basis for the Services or Optional Services performed, and client shall provide payment within 45 days. Invoices shall be submitted to the Belvedere Municipal Utility District, c/o Jeff Monzingo, Montoya & Monzingo LLP, P.O. Box 2029, Pflugerville, TX 78691. The billing schedule for the Services will occur according to the schedule provided in <u>Exhibit B</u>, and the Optional Services will be separately billed.
- 3. The Client may elect to discontinue service with Sunscape Landscaping any time during the term of this Contract by notify Sunscape Landscaping with a 30 day written notification sent to the address set forth above. The Client will be responsible for full payment of Services received up to the time of termination.
- 4. Sunscape Landscaping will furnish all Services including all labor, materials, supplies and equipment. Services to include:
 - Rake/scrape and manicure the decomposed granite.
 - Correct, repair, and compact eroded rills and gullies following concentrated storm runoff crossing the decomposed granite trails.
 - Provide additional compacted decomposed granite as needed to replace lost material, and establish a smooth, consistent compacted trail surface.
 - Replace stones that become dislodged from the trail borders.
 - Remove debris and sediment from culverts.

- Remove trash and litter from trail areas during each visit, and remove it from the District. This does not include emptying trash cans along the trail.
- Remove animal waste from trail areas during each visit, and remove it from the District.
- · Control fire ants within the trail surfaces.
- Clean benches, swings and exercise equipment along the trails, as well as the playscape equipment and the benches adjacent thereto every 6 months.
- 5. Additional maintenance or minor repair items to landscaping, trails, or other facilities on the Premises may be requested by Client or Client's representative in writing ("Optional Services"). The Optional Services will be billed on a monthly basis.
- 6. Sunscape Landscaping will make a representative available to attend Client Board meetings to provide a report at the request of the Client.
- 7. Sunscape Landscaping shall at all times be solely responsible and liable for any damage caused by Sunscape landscaping, its staff, employee and sub-contractors to any of Client's equipment, property or fixtures and make all repairs and/or replacement to substantially the condition as existed before the damage for any such damage without cost to Client.
- 8. Sunscape Landscaping shall at all times maintain liability insurance coverage to cover any claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise in connection with the performance of the Services by Sunscape Landscaping, its staff, employees and sub-contractors. Coverage shall in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000 Commercial General Liability and \$1,000,000 Automobile Liability. Sunscape Landscaping shall also provide workers' compensation insurance for its staff, employees and sub-contractors in compliance with state requirements. Contractor shall provide proof of liability insurance and workers' compensation insurance and any other certificates or documents reflecting that Sunscape Landscaping is in full compliance with all legal requirements and obligations for companies providing Services.
- 9. The parties acknowledge that (I) the relationship between Client and Sunscape Landscaping is that of an independent contractor and client and (ii) Sunscape Landscaping alone has exclusive control and supervision of its staff, employees and sub-contractors. Nothing herein shall be construed to mean that Sunscape Landscaping or any of its staff, employees or sub-contractors are agents, employees or representatives of Client.
- 10. Sunscape Landscaping shall at all times ensure that industry accepted safety standards and practices are followed while performing the Services. Sunscape Landscaping shall at all times comply with all ordinances, laws, regulations and other legal requirements and obligation of the applicable jurisdiction while performing the Services.
- 11. Sunscape Landscaping agrees to indemnify and save harmless Client, its officers, agents, servants and employees for and against any and all suits, actions, legal proceedings, claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, and attorney's fees, arising out of the Sunscape Landscaping's willful or negligent act or omission under this Contract, including Sunscape Landscaping's officers, agents, servants, and employees.
- 12. This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersede all prior agreements, representations, warranties, statements, promises, information, arrangements and understands, whether oral or written, express or implied, with respect to the subject matter hereof. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provisions of this Contract invalid or unenforceable, the remaining terms shall remain in full force and effect. This contract shall be
