In October, we travelled north within 100 miles of the Canadian border to Great Falls, Montana. Pastor Bobby King of CrossRoads Memorial Church along with a couple sister churches strongly desire to see a new church plant in the city of Great Falls. They see that the "harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few" (Luke 10:2). God allowed us to

coordinate a visit between Pastor Bobby and a church planter who is currently going through the process of being endorsed by North American Mission Board. As a result, in November this church planting couple has started working with CrossRoads Memorial and the church is growing after some setbacks. It'll be exciting to see how God multiplies and grows His churches in Great Falls!

After a week in Great Falls, we traveled back down to Whitehall for Expedition Church's October worship gathering. Even though Expedition Church is 85 miles away in Livingston and only a few years old itself, they feels a burden to share the gospel and encourage the spiritual growth of the people in
